Chair not bothered by 'flyer'


Halton Board of Education Chair Diane Leblovic is neither insulted nor bothered by the fact that Milton Trustee Tim Kingsbury did not notify the Board before announcing his intent to distribute a flyer that will become "the sole basis" for a name change to McKenzie-Smith and M.Z. Ben-nett schools.

Leblovic, by phone on Monday, actually praised Kingsbury for his efforts in getting involved with the community and trying to resolve the naming issue.

"Individual trustees deal with their communities in their own individual way," she said.

Following a public meeting in the M.Z. Bennett library on Sept. 11, attended by parents, teachers, parent group members and Acton trustee candidates, Kingsbury told The Tanner that the flyer would be the sole basis of the name change, unless "I got two names which would be absurd to go by."

When asked what he would do if the Board didn't approve of his flyer, Kingsbury said "it doesn't

"the Board will have to consider the results from the flyer, along with other information."

Namely the 172 people who apparently have responded either by phone, fax or in person at Kingsbury's Campbellville residence. Kingsbury admits that 37 per cent of those prefer either McKenzie-Smith-Bennett or Bennett-McKenzie-Smith.

"But at the end of the day," Leblovic said, "the corporate body makes the final decision."
