Mayor Marilyn Serjeantson of every decision made. "has big plans for the Acton arena!" This project remains a top priority for the Town, she added. Her wish was echoed by councillors Norm Elliott and Gerald Rennie. The new arena will show that Acton has benefited from being part of Halton Hills, said Elliott, who chairs the building committee for the arena.

Serjeantson would also like to see the Town's budget kept at a zero per cent tax increase, while still keeping up a high level of services to residents. East-end development in Acton is on Rennie's wish-list for early in the new year.

BIA co-ordinator Janis Fread wants to see every downtown storefront filled with businesses that can thrive in Acton, and wants existing businesses to keep up with facade improvements.

"It is an attractive downtown and I'd like to see it stay that way," Fread said.

Also on her wish list is the return of the Village Constable program as it was during the 1980s, "to make merchants feel more secure." Fread said a real wish is to see the Leathertown Festival continue in 1996 if there was a way to generate volunteer interest in the community.






