In addition to the babysitting, the two mothers and their four children have made trips to the mall together and spent time at each other's homes. By coinci-



Damage from the fire amounted to between \$15,000 and \$18,000. The helpful neighbour was treated for stitches on his hand. He cut himself while breaking the kitchen window in order to use the fire extinguisher.


