But if she could pick a favourite, it would have to be Rogue, a female super hero out of the X-Men series.

She would like to be able to become Rita Hayworth, Audrey Hepburn, "in her Breakfast at Tiffany's look," one of the singing Andrews sisters and even Marilyn Monroe. 
