This column will appear on a regular basis to bring you news from the Acton BIA. The Acton BIA (Business Improvement Area) boundaries were set by the Town of Halton Hills Council in 1977 and included all businesses bordered by Bower Avenue, Knox Street, Park Avenue, Main Street, one block on Agnes Street, Church Street and Eastern Avenue. In 1993 the boundaries were extended to include the olde Hide House. The mandate of the BIA, as outlined in the provincial Municipal Act, is to beautify, promote and improve although the current government is in the process of reviewing this with the thought of expanding the role of BIAs.

The Acton BIA Board of Managers consists of seven volunteer managers appointed by Council, one of whom is a Town of Halton Hills Councillor. The Board has hired a part-time promotions coordinator and a part-time street maintenance employee.
