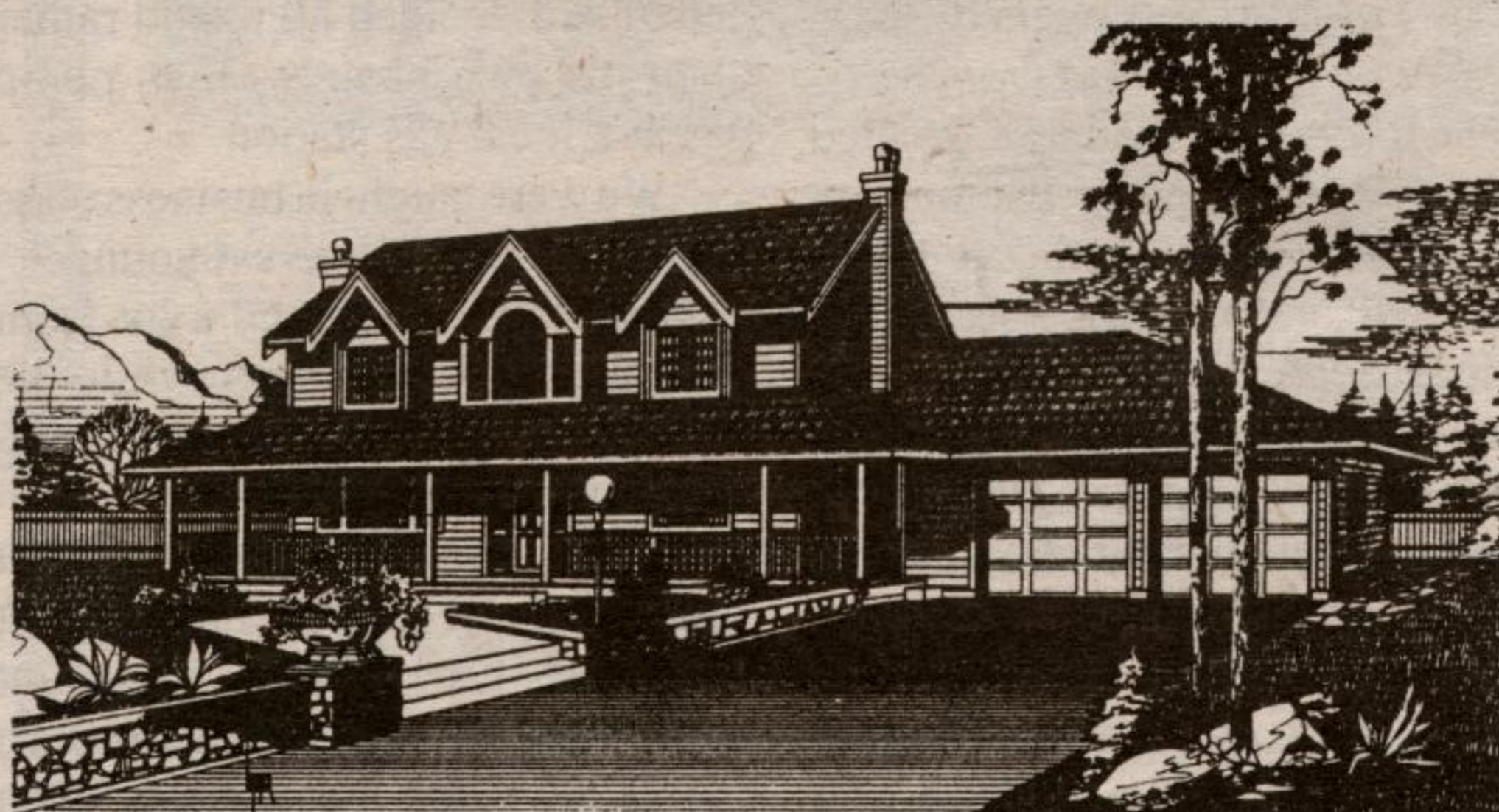

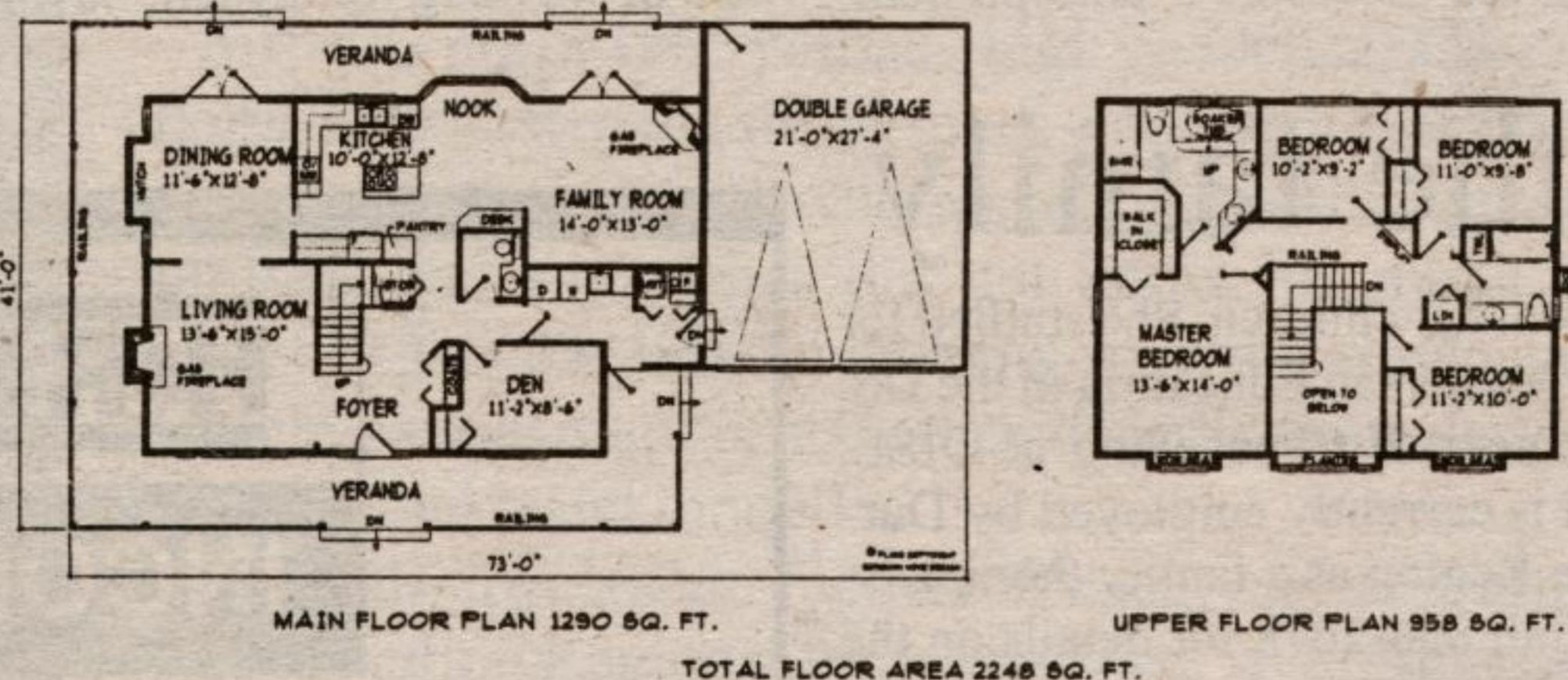
A 'Heritage' style starter
