Chudleigh introduces private members bill

Ted Chudleigh, MPP for Halton North, has introduced a bill which will protect heritage buildings in Milton.

Under the current Ontario Heritage Act, there is nothing to prevent the demolition of potentially historic structures that have not been so designated by the Town of Milton. Such demolition can be stalled for a six-month period, after which the applicant can make an application for a permit and demolition can proceed.

The town of Milton passed a resolution in July 1994 requesting a private members bill to deal with Chudleigh added.

the problem of demolition of heritage buildings within the town.

"The community of Milton has lost significant historical buildings through demolition in the past," Chudleigh said. "I was pleased to be able to stand in the Legislature and present Bill Pr-50 on behalf of the Town of Milton."

"Our heritage is something that we should never take for granted. If we are reckless and destroy monuments to our past, we lose a sense of history. We must respect our heritage or we are destined to repeat the errors of the past."




