University tests prove that using a mulching mower actually contributes to a healthier, greener lawn. Mulching mowers cut and re-cut clippings and return them to the grass. Because grass clippings are 85 per cent water, they decompose quickly, returning water and 20 per cent of their nitrogen back to the earth.

Many people believe that

returning grass clippings to the lawn causes thatch, but that's simply not true. Thatch is caused by shallow watering, overfertilization and improper mowing – not by mulching.

And when fall rolls around and the leaves start to fall, save yourself a pain in the back by mulching leaves. Rather than bagging leaves, return them to the lawn. By attaching a material collection system to your walk-behind mower, you can mulch and redistribute your leaves - either in a natural area or as mulch around trees and shrubs.
