The Pee wee Rams trounced Guelph 12-3 and defeated Milton 8-6 for their two victories.

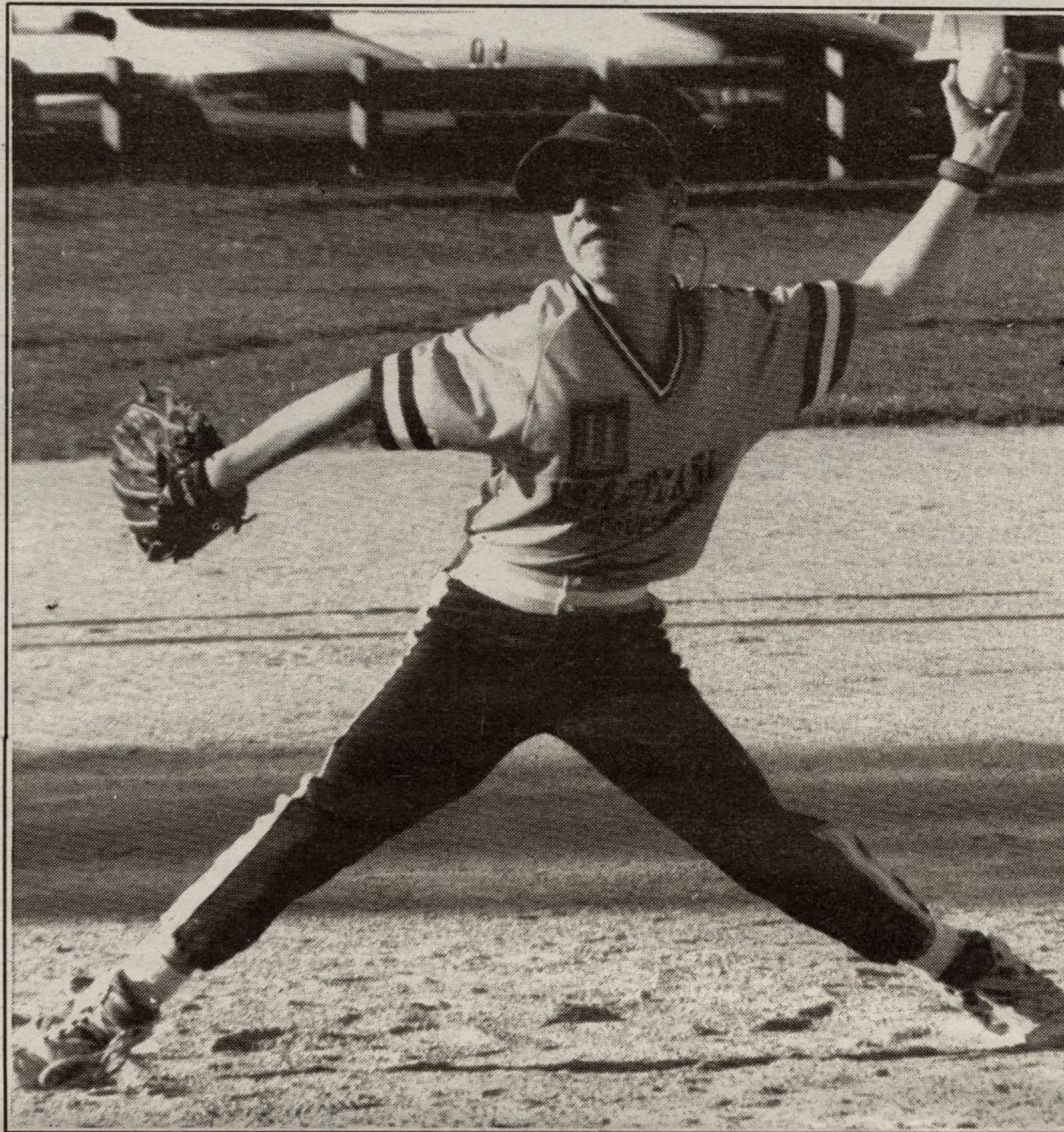
In the game against Guelph both Adam Lindsay and Matt Wolfer had hat tricks and single assists while Nick Mastro had two goals and an assist
