vidual who needs someone to stay overnight but does not fit the Homecare requirements. It may meet the needs of a working adult child who is caregiving for a parent in the home, or provide respite hours for someone who is caring for a family member with a long-term illness.

Every situation is different, therefore companions will be matched according to the need. Fees are charged by the caregiver/companion but are reasonable.
