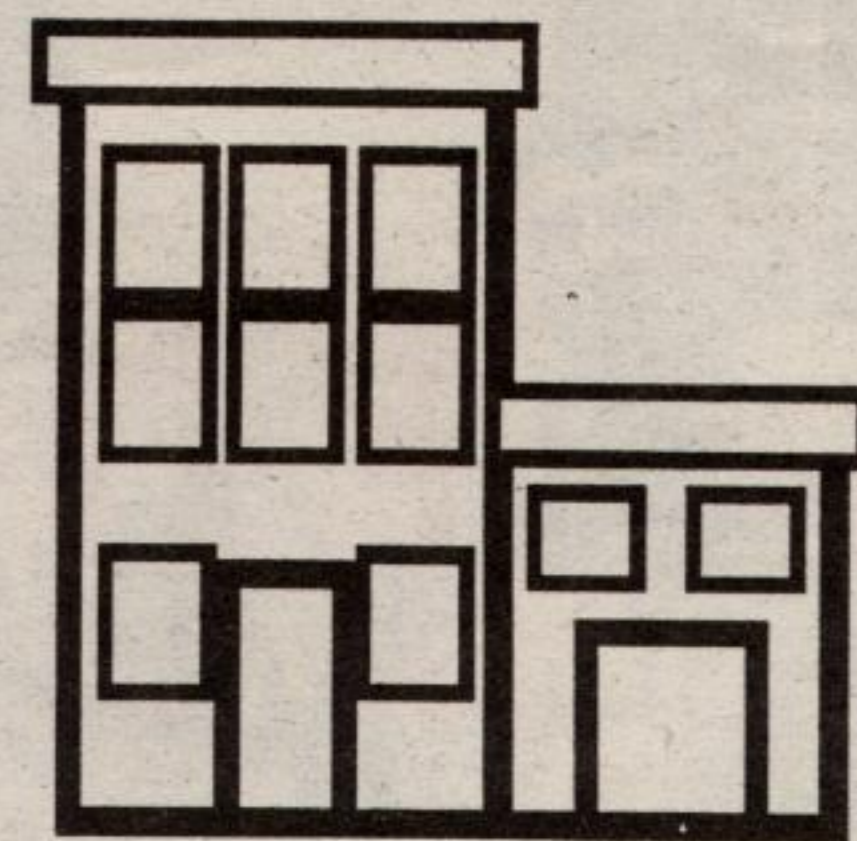

## Campbellville: Shoppers' and browsers' paradise

The hamlet is named after the first settler, John Campbell. His original 1832 log home, now stuccoed, still stands today at 37 Campbell Ave. W.

In 1836 he dammed the stream for a pond and erected a saw-mill, Campbellville's first business. Later

John laid out a hamlet plan to attract other newcomers. Roads improved and blacksmiths, storekeepers and cobblers set up shop. Soon there was a woolen mill, churches and a schoolhouse and in 1880 the Credit Valley Railway pushed a line through the valley and the hamlet had its own station. Unfortunately, fire has since claimed several of the major older buildings.

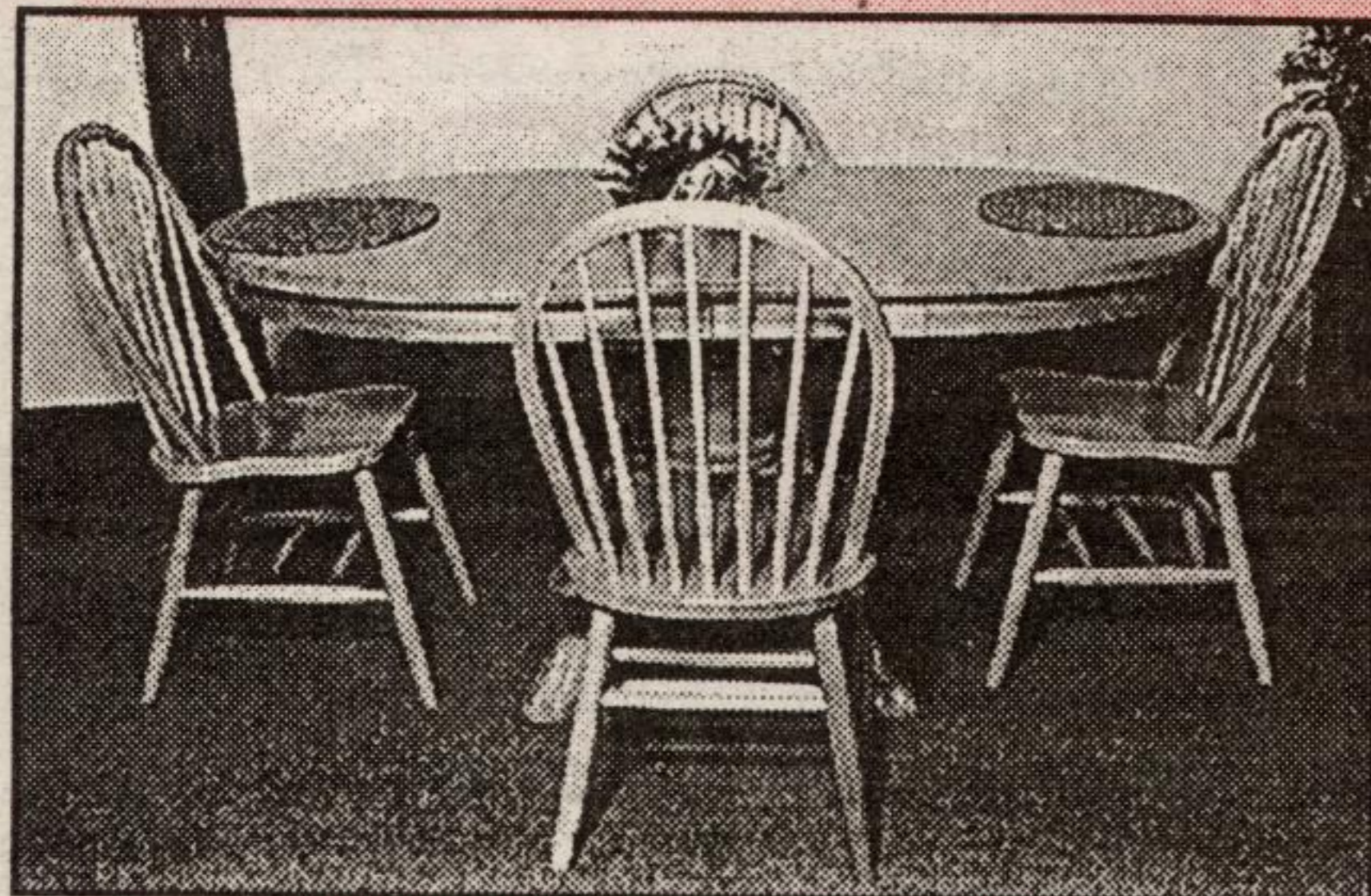

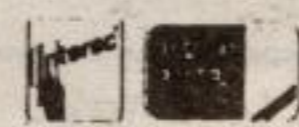
