## United Aggregates Ltd. court summons coming

By now, officials with United Aggregates Limited (UAL) should have been served with a court summons, instructing them to be in a Milton court on Monday, Aug. 12 in connection with a private prosecution launched by local environmentalists and the Sierra Legal Defense Fund.

The charge, sworn before a Halton Justice of the Peace

earlier this month, alleges that UAL is carrying out illegal quarrying at its Acton Quarry because it has not applied for, or received, a permit from the Niagara Escarpment Commission, despite a ruling by the Ontario Court of Appeal in March that the company needed such a permit to continue operating the quarry.

Doug Chapman, a Sierra Legal Defense Fund lawyer, said he checked with the Justice of the Peace on Monday and was told the paperwork would be served on Monday or Tuesday (yesterday) by Peel Police, which cover Mississauga, where UAL's head office is located.

UAL officials would not comment on the allegations

without seeing the summons.

"We still haven't seen anything beyond the fax that Sierra sent us on July 5 when they had their press conference at the quarry," explained UAL operations manager Malcolm Barr last Thursday.

Barr said they were "certainly concerned" with the allegations of quarrying without the proper permit, but can't react to them until they officially get notice of the private prosecution.

Barr said with the court date scheduled for August 12, they are unable to prepare a defense.

"How can you prepare for something that you're not officially aware of? Until we get something official I can't comment."
