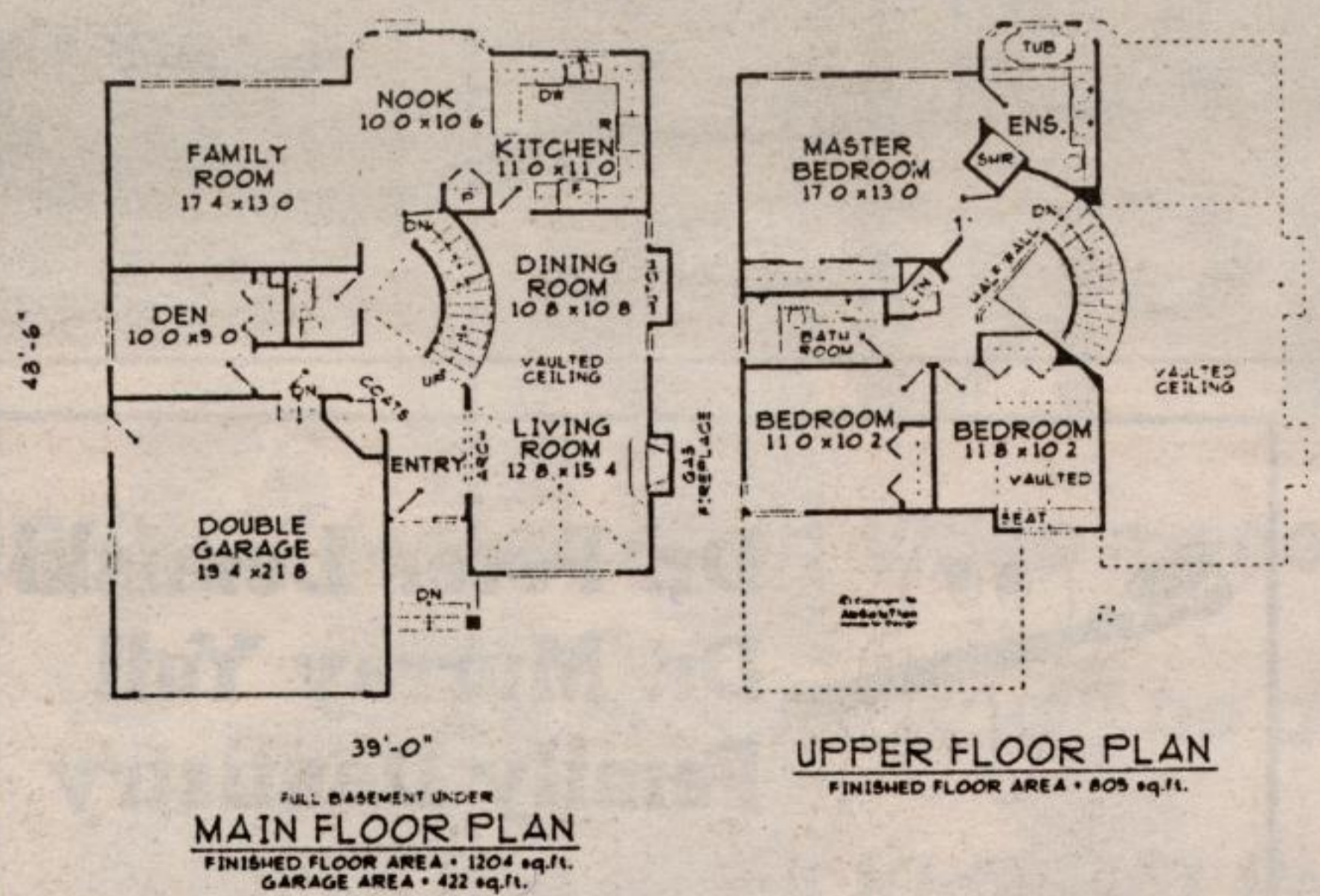
Family home boasts many features
