

T.E.A.M. moves location

The TEAM (Teen Education and Motherhood) program is moving from the Acton Baptist Church to St. George's Anglican Church, 60 Guelph Street, Georgetown.

The TEAM Program has existed since 1987 and is one of the alternative education programs offered by Adult and Continuing Education (Halton Board of Education). It offers pregnant teens and young mothers the opportunity to work towards their high school diploma in a supportive, non-threatening atmosphere. Courses offered are geared directly to independent learning modes, and require no specialized equipment or materials other than

a computer. Students are able to work at their own pace and on material geared to their levels of ability. Courses are offered from basic to advanced levels, with some OAC courses. A parenting course is an integral part of the program.

On-site childcare is provided at no cost to the students for children six-weeks to school age.

This program is delivered through a partnership between Adult and Continuing Education of the Halton Board of Education, Ministry of Community and Social Services of the Region of Halton, and various child care provider agencies.

Registration is being held at St. George's Anglican Church (beside Georgetown High) in the banquet room, on August 29 from 12:30 to 3:30 pm.

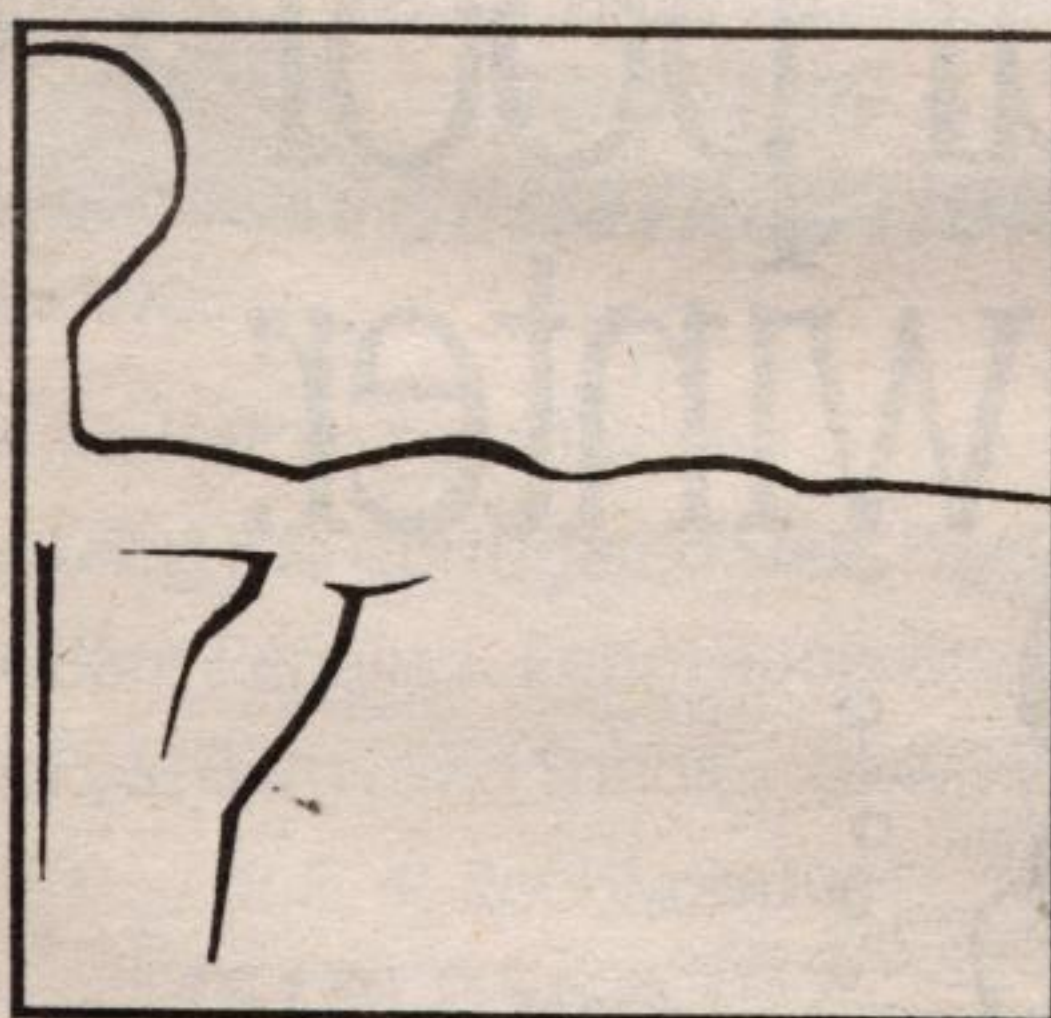

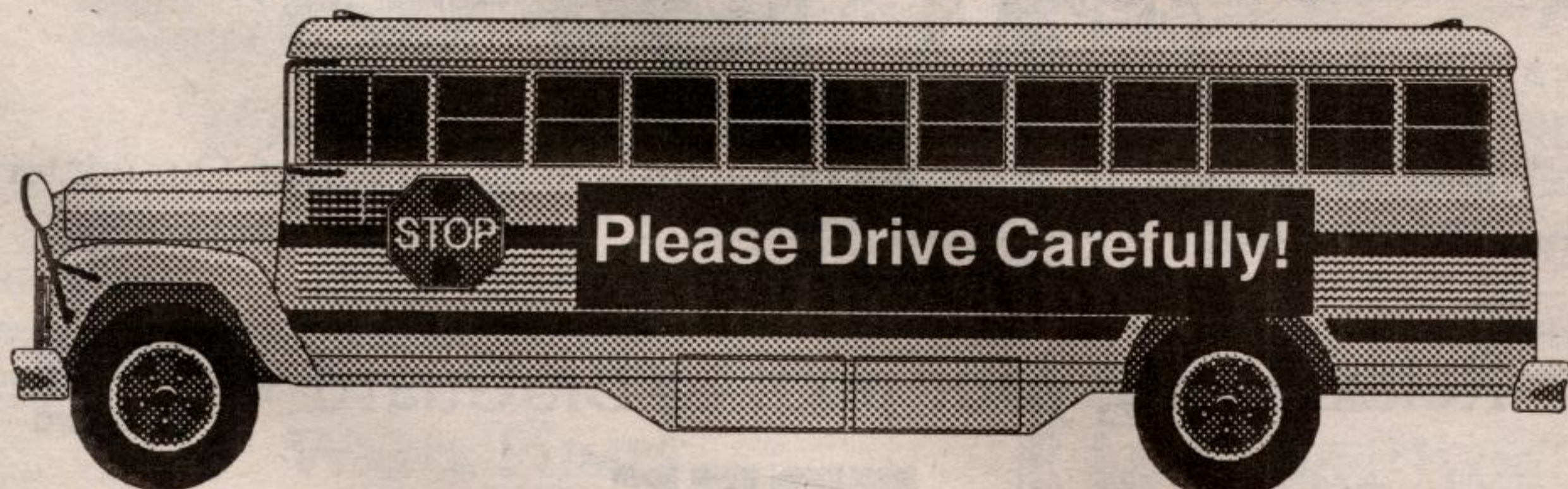
