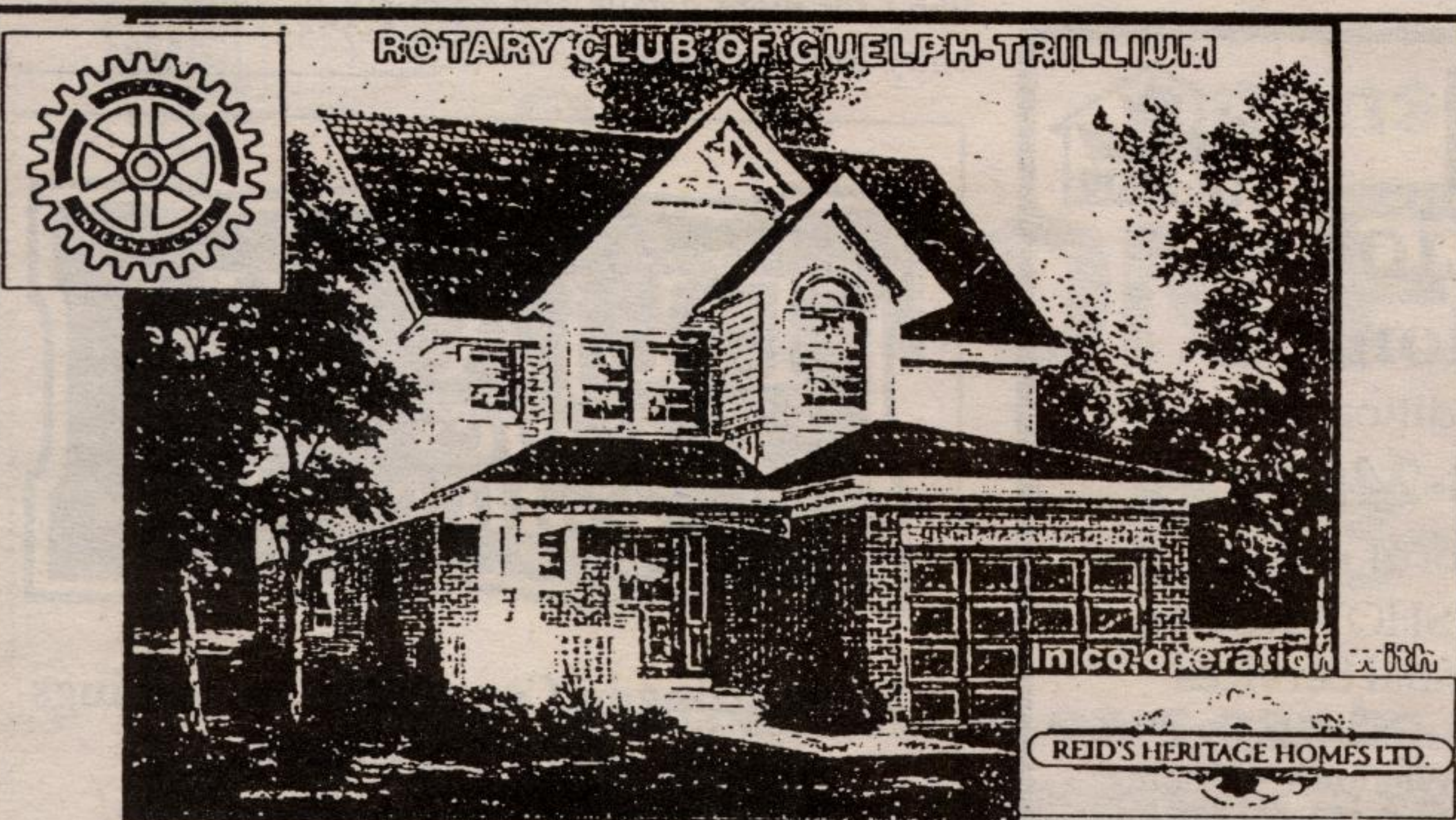

'Road Watch' launched

The Halton Regional Police Service, in conjunction with the Halton Hills Rural Community Consultation Committee, has introduced a traffic safety initiative, the Road Watch Program.

This initiative is a pilot program designed to incorporate three major components: awareness, education and enforcement.

Road Watch was originally launched in the town of Caledon in January 1995. The resulting success was the driving force behind this pilot project put forth by the Halton Hills CCC.

Through the use of citizen report forms, Road Watch will identify aggressive drivers (i.e. speeding, following too close, unsafe lane changes) in the Halton Hills community.

Citizen report forms are completed if you observe an act of aggressive driving on Halton Hills roads. They can be dropped off at the front desk of the Georgetown police station at 217 Guelph St. where they will be kept in a secure file.

Report forms will be collected and investigated on a regular basis by police. Vio-

lators will be contacted by the police service in a manner outlined by the program.

Citizens should remember, however, that incidents of an urgent nature may still be reported to the police by dialing 911 or the local police number, 853-2111.
