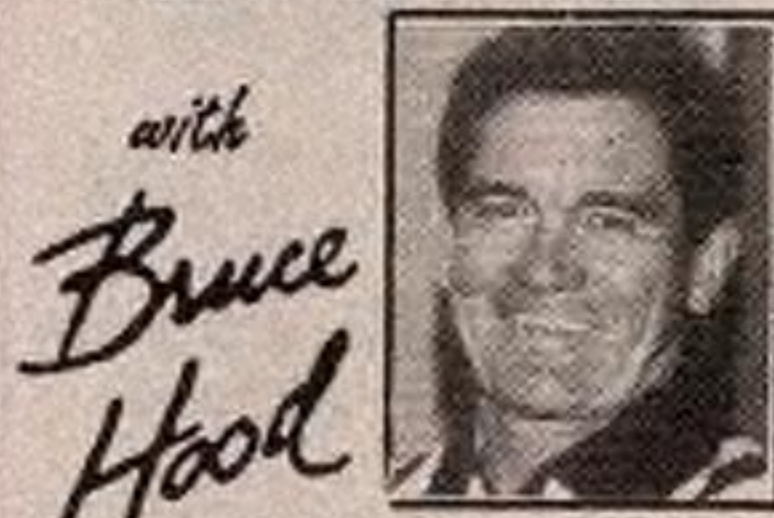

**HOMEPLAN OF THE WEEK!**  
*Rear View Home Suits Sloping Lot*

This design suits property that slopes from the front down to the back. From the front it looks like a rancher; from the rear, a two storey with main floor and daylight basement fully exposed.

Enter into a vaulted foyer. An arched entrance leads into the sitting room/dining room area which features two boxed out window seats and a cosy gas fireplace. The kitchen boasts an efficient "U" shaped work area with plenty of cupboard and counter space, a pantry, and an open counter to service nook. The family room, open to the nook and kitchen, provides a spacious and comfortable area for relaxation, and features a vaulted ceiling, a gas fireplace, and sliding french doors which lead out to a huge deck.

The master also has access to the deck, and features a walk-in closet and a four piece ensuite.
