as smart as May, as she was the big winner.

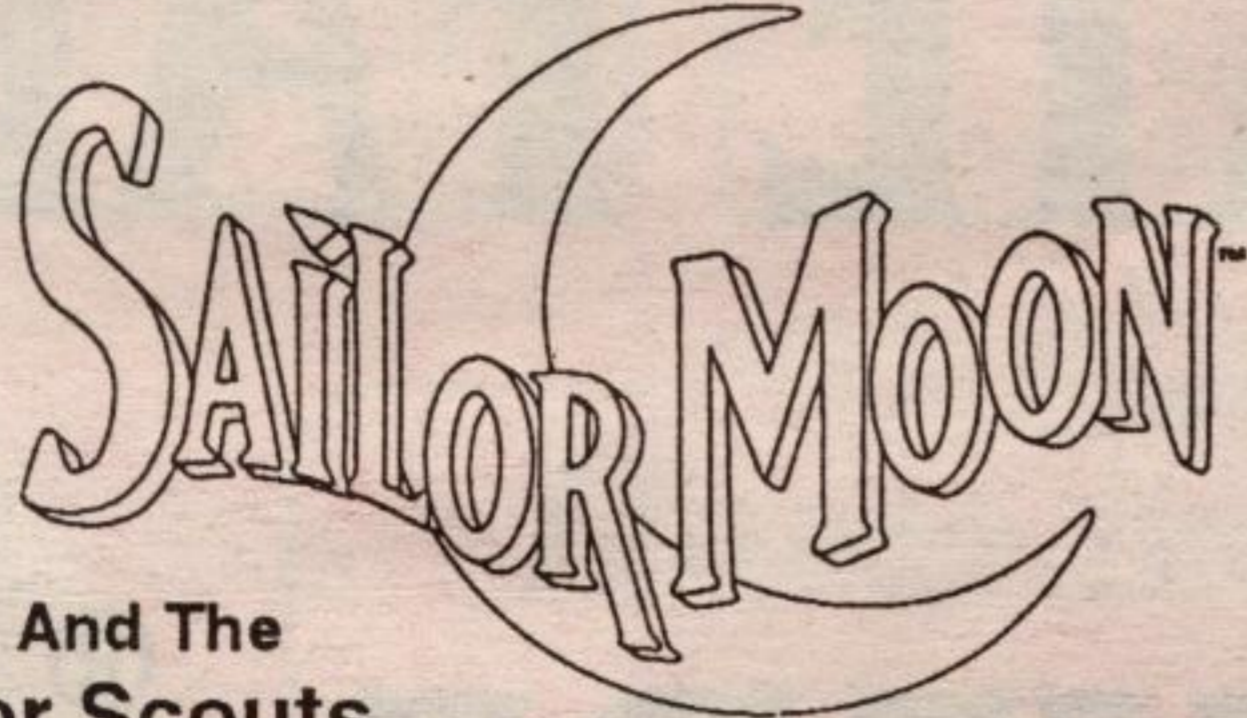
Our next meeting will be Nov. 5 at 7:30 pm at Knox Church. Come and join us if you have a spare hour, and see how we try to help others.
