

## Businesses get help

After five years as owner of the architectural design firm Bev Gray and Associates, Acton's Bev Gray decided it was time for her to get some information about being a small business owner.

Gray signed up for a Chamber of Commerce course for entrepreneurs called "Head Start" and hopes it will help make her next five years in business as successful as her first five.

"I have a registered business but I'm not a corporation and I'm curious about that end of things," Gray explained on Saturday.

Developed by Don Crosley, executive vice-president

of the Oakville Chamber, the 10-hour "Head Start" course covers nine areas including record keeping, designing a business plan, cash flow projections, marketing and choosing and managing a banker. Invited guests to each session will include a lawyer, accountant and banker who will answer questions and give advice.

The course is offered in two sessions on Nov. 7 from 6-9 pm and for seven hours on Nov. 9.

Although registration is almost full, the Chamber will offer it again if there is enough interest. The cost is \$50. For details call 877-7119.



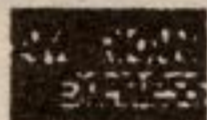
