Six Weeks 'Til Christmas
This week's tips about Christmas shopping relate to shopping store to store.

1. As you shop try to maintain a minimum load of parcels, keep one arm free. This may mean more trips back to the car, but it lessens your vulnerability.
2. Ladies, your purse is always a target for thieves. Keep it in your hand - do not put the strap around your neck. Do not carry large amounts of cash. If possible, keep your cash and credit cards in your pocket. If someone tries to take your purse, you may well avoid personal harm by just letting go.
3. If you use credit cards, maintain a list with the card number, issuer and the emergency cancellation number, to be used as soon as you notice your card is missing.
4. When using an ATM, be aware of your surroundings and who is watching. Do not stand by the machine counting money.
5. When you are shopping, always try to have someone with you. A person alone is much more vulnerable.
