

# Assault with remote Downtown bakery to open Feb. 1

Police arrested a 23-year-old Churchill Road man following a domestic assault in which a 19-year-old female was assaulted with a television remote control unit.

Police report that the incident followed an argument. The man is alleged to have pulled the victim's hair, thrown her on the bed, pushed her into the living room and struck her on the back of the head when he threw the remote control at her.

The victim sustained minor injuries. The man faces charges of assault, assault with a weapon and mischief.

Acton residents will soon have another source for sticky buns, fresh bread and other baked treats — the Bread Basket bakery will open next month at 45 Mill St. E.

New Acton residents Jill and Richard Mallon are currently renovating the leased store and if all goes well, will open their doors on Feb. 1.

"We owned a bakery in Calgary and when we moved to Acton from Mississauga several months ago we wanted to open a business and saw that there wasn't a bakery in town. So that's what we decided to do," Jill Mallon, the baker in the family, explained last Thursday.

"We will have a full range of bakery items including bread, buns, cakes, donuts, cookies and muffins and plan to open a deli lunch counter after we get going. We won't have any place for people to sit and eat but will have sandwiches, soup or chili for take-out," Mallon said.

Mallon said they will be open seven days a week, likely from 7 am until 7 pm and plan to hire two or three staff.

"We've asked some people what they would like to be able to buy in town and a lot of people asked for Chelsea buns so that's something we'll have for sure. We are also talking with Chudleigh's and may have their pies for sale as well," Mallon said.

Building owner Jon Hurst said extensive renovations were required to bring the building up to standards of the current Ontario Fire Code, including removing the unique tin ceiling to install insulation and then replacing the tin.

Mallon said she's encouraging other Acton businesses to put up displays of their products on the bakery's walls to increase local advertising.

Each business will be charged \$50 per month for use of the space.

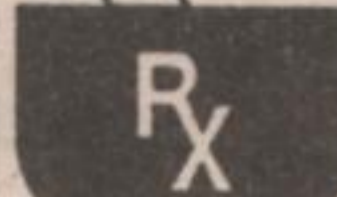
