Planning begun for Firefighter's first pageant

If you are a poised, single female between 16 and 21 years of age and know about the Eramosa Fire Department, then organizers of the first Miss Eramosa Firefighter Pageant want you.

Stressing that it's *not* a beauty pageant, but admitting that contestants will be judged, in part, on their appearance, pageant chair Brenda Nelson explained that the wives of Eramosa's volunteer firefighters, the Eramosa Ladies' Auxiliary, decided that the Township should have someone to represent it, like other fire departments do.

"A lot of the volunteer fire departments choose a girl from their community to represent them at dinners, parades and public events and represent their community's firefighters at the annual firefighters' convention, which

this year will be in Arthur," Nelson explained Friday.

Contestants will be judged on their appearance, poise, grooming and general knowledge of the Eramosa Fire Department and the community in general. The winner will receive a cash award, a plaque and token gifts.

Asked why the pageant was only open to females, Nelson said it was because all the other fire departments that hold pageants are only open to women.

"It (allowing males) never came up. Everyone else does the ladies but you have a good point," Nelson admitted.

Organizers will hold an information night for potential contestants on Wednesday, March 12 at the Fire Hall in Rockwood at 7 p.m. Judging will take place Pioneer Day weekend at Rockmosa on Friday, June 13.
