## Assessment clinic offered

Do you have questions about your preschooler's development? A "Screening Clinic" will be held at the Acton Children's Corner on Feb. 25 from 9:30 to 11:30 am, during regular drop-in hours. The Children's Corner is located at the Salvation Army (church basement) at 114 Mill St.

The clinic will assess your pre-schooler's development in the areas of learning, hearing, speech/language, behaviour and motor skills. Trained staff from the Milton District Hospital and Preschool Assessment and Training in Halton (PATH) will be on hand to help answer your questions. There is no charge for the screening clinic. Health will be available at Georgetown and District Memorial Hospital to register or re-issue Health Cards for replacement of damaged, lost or stolen cards, new registrations and change of last names. Appointments can be made for: Feb. 17 from 9 am to 4:30 pm; Feb. 18 from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm; and Feb. 19 from 8:30 am to 4 pm.

You will need three different original documents: Canadian birth certificate, Canadian citizenship or immigration status document; current document with your name and home address (e.g. Ontario driver's license, utility bill); and a document with your name and signature.

Your children aged 15½ years or younger don't have to go with you because they don't have a photo on their card. Just bring an original document to show their Ca-

nadian citizenship or immigration status. You must make an appointment by calling (905)896-6609.
