Shop offers 'gently-used' clothing

A thrift shop and food bank are two of the new services being offered by The East Wellington Advisory Group for Family Services (EWAG) in Rockwood.

EWAG spokesperson Kim Lewis said they are looking for volunteers willing to help operate both services at EWAG's office at 126 Main Street.

"The EWAG Community Services Thrift Shop is a fundraising proposition and all the proceeds go right back into the community for the Seniors' Resource Centre, the Children's Connection and the Food Pantry," Lewis explained last Thursday.

The Food Pantry began during the holiday season as a local church project that EWAG decided to continue, to meet the needs of local residents.

"We're looking for dona-

tions of gently-used clothing and non-perishable food. The majority of items in the Thrift Shop now came from the Thrift Shop in Erin and we will accept anything that people have to offer," Lewis said.

The Thrift Shop and Food Pantry are open Monday to Friday from 9 am until 4 pm. Both children's and adults' clothing are available.
