Held at the Georgetown Fairgrounds and the first fall fair of the year in the North Halton area, the popular fair provides a traditional Midway cloaked in a carnival atmosphere, homecrafts and many agricultural exhibits. It also features sanctioned truck and tractor pulls, a demolition derby and horse and pony shows. The Fair officially opens to the public on Friday afternoon at 4:00 p.m. with the Midway opening at 4:30 p.m. What follows is a weekend of music, cotton candy, thrills and spills - all wrapped around enough activities to keep the whole family fully entertained.

The Georgetown Fall Fair is now accepting applications for the 1998/99 Fair Ambassador Competition. 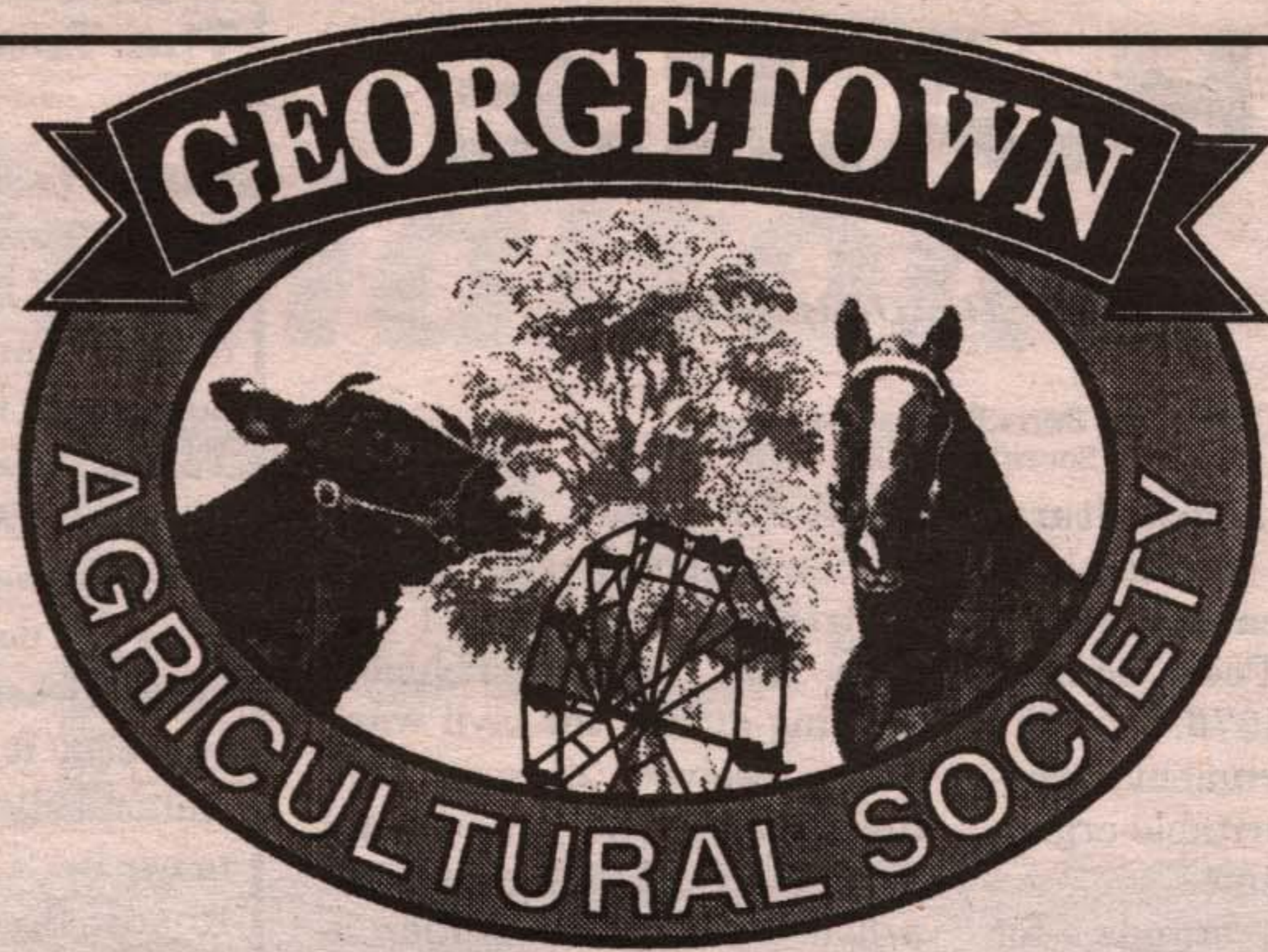

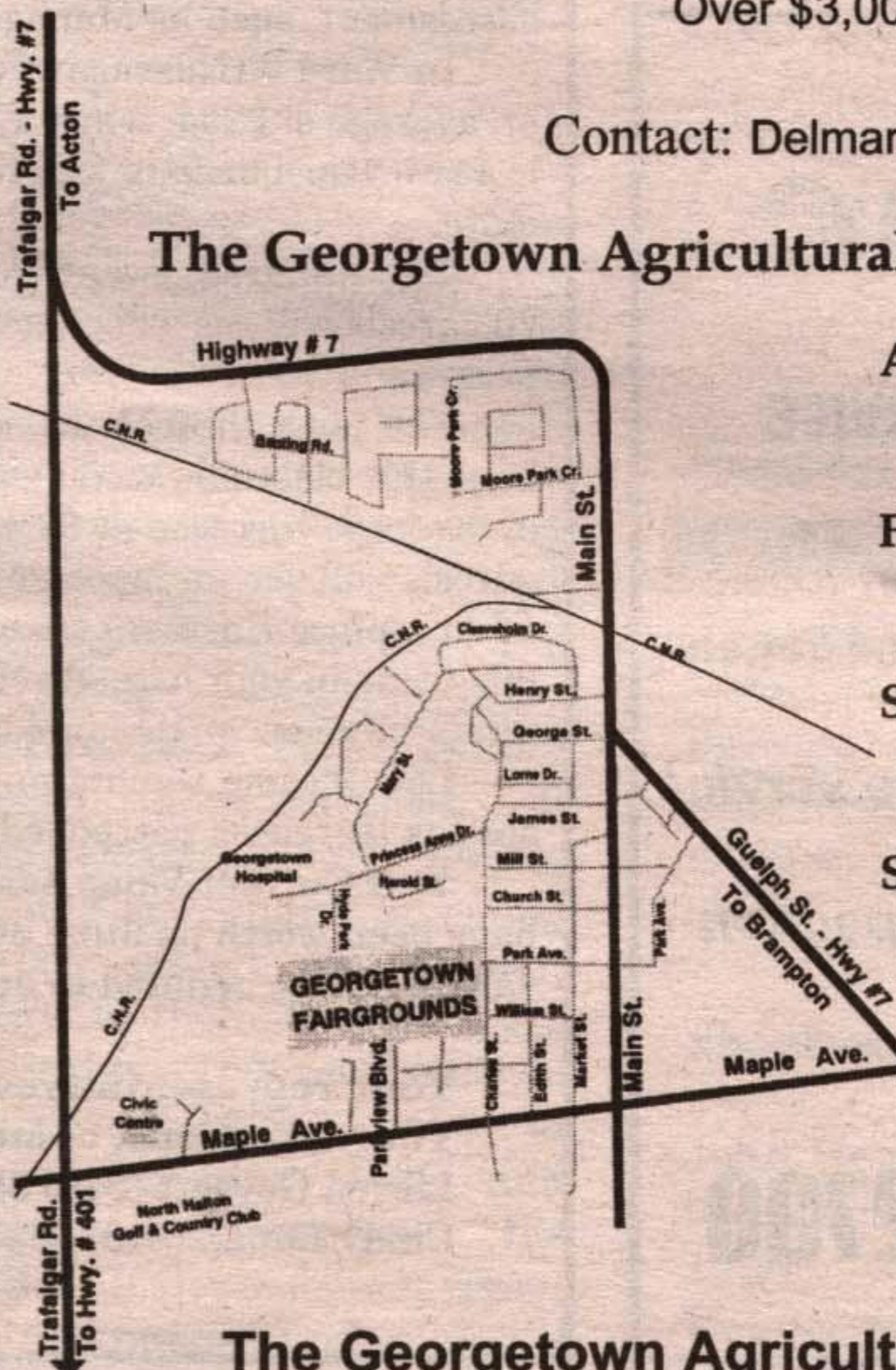
