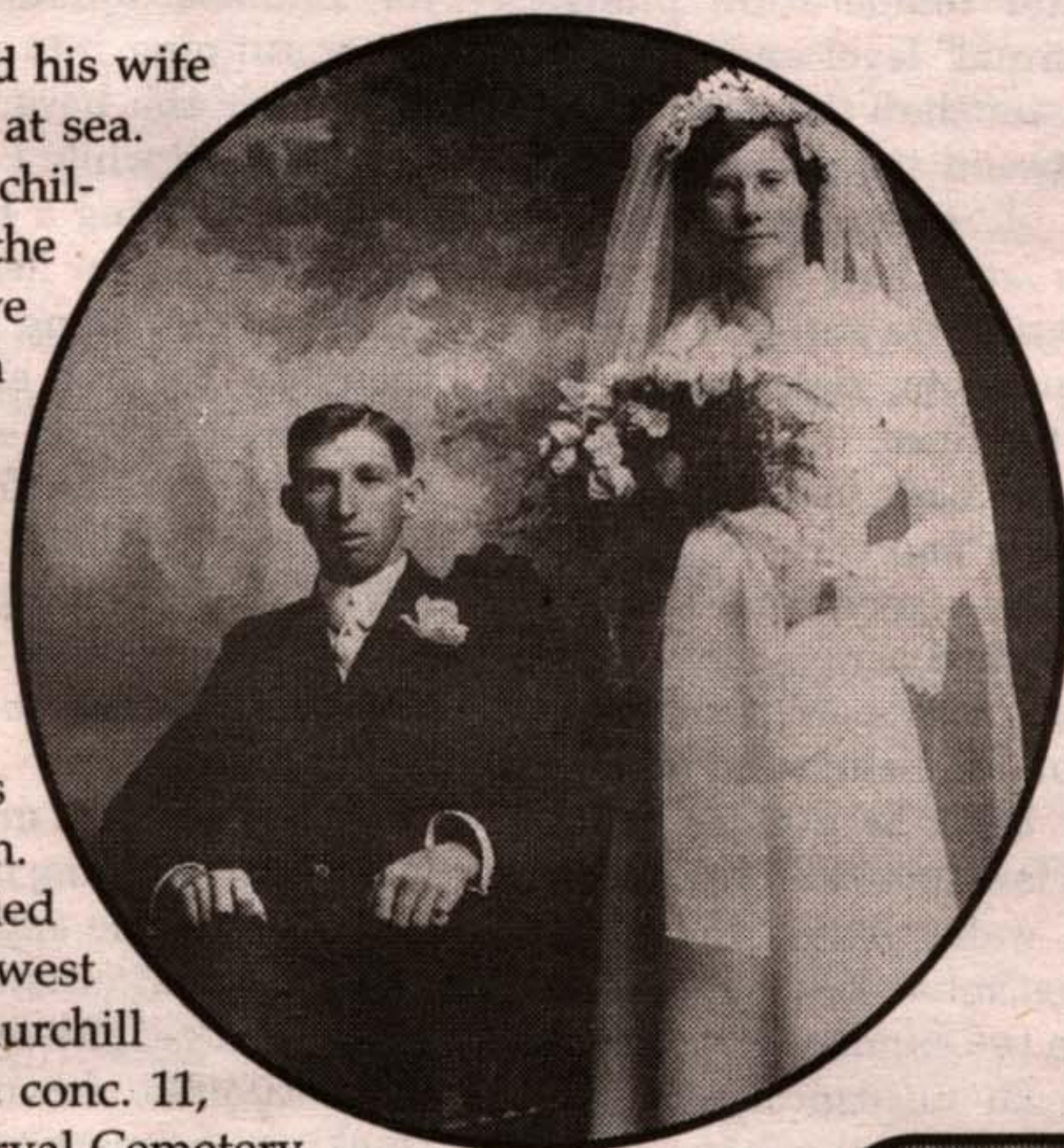

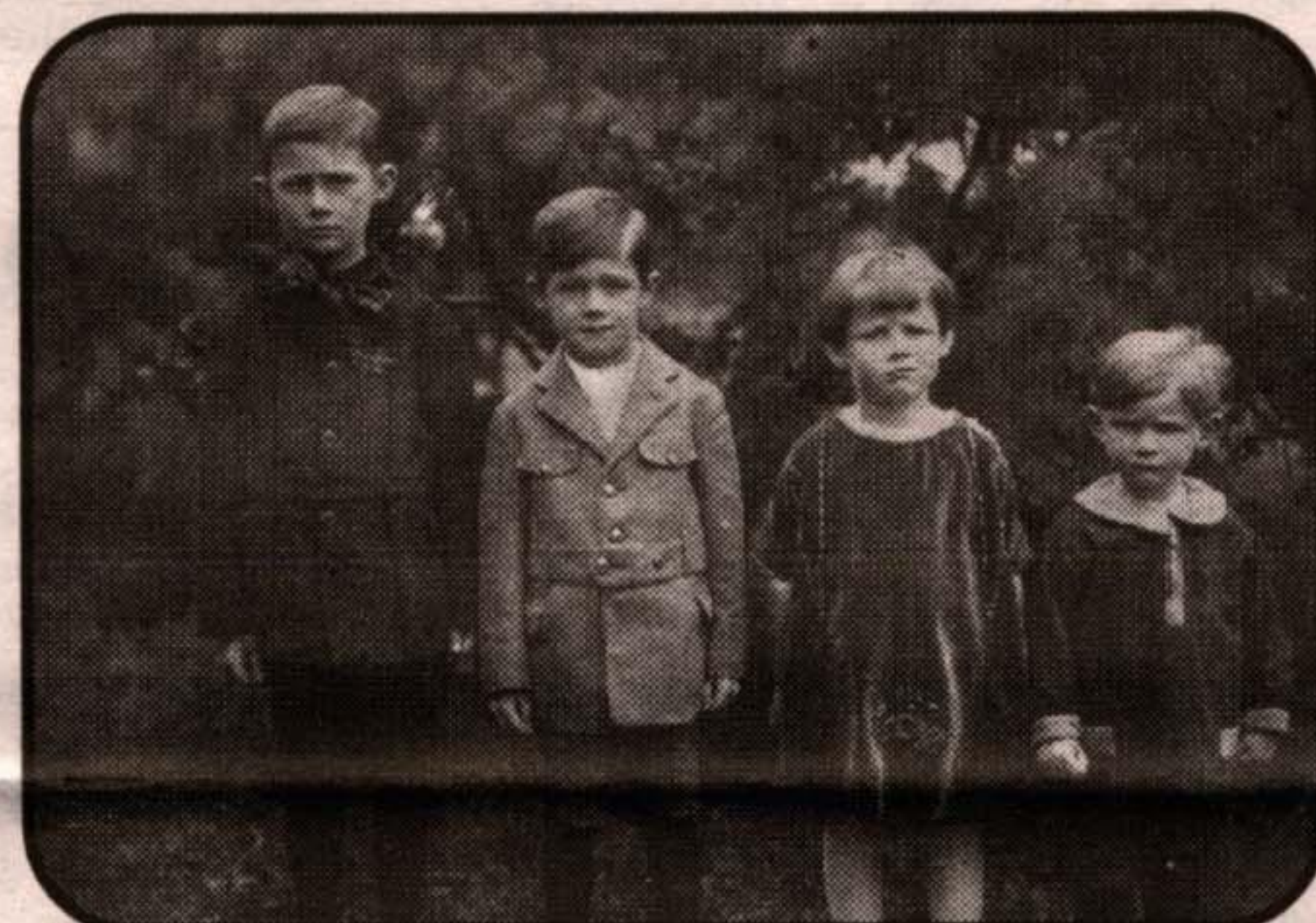

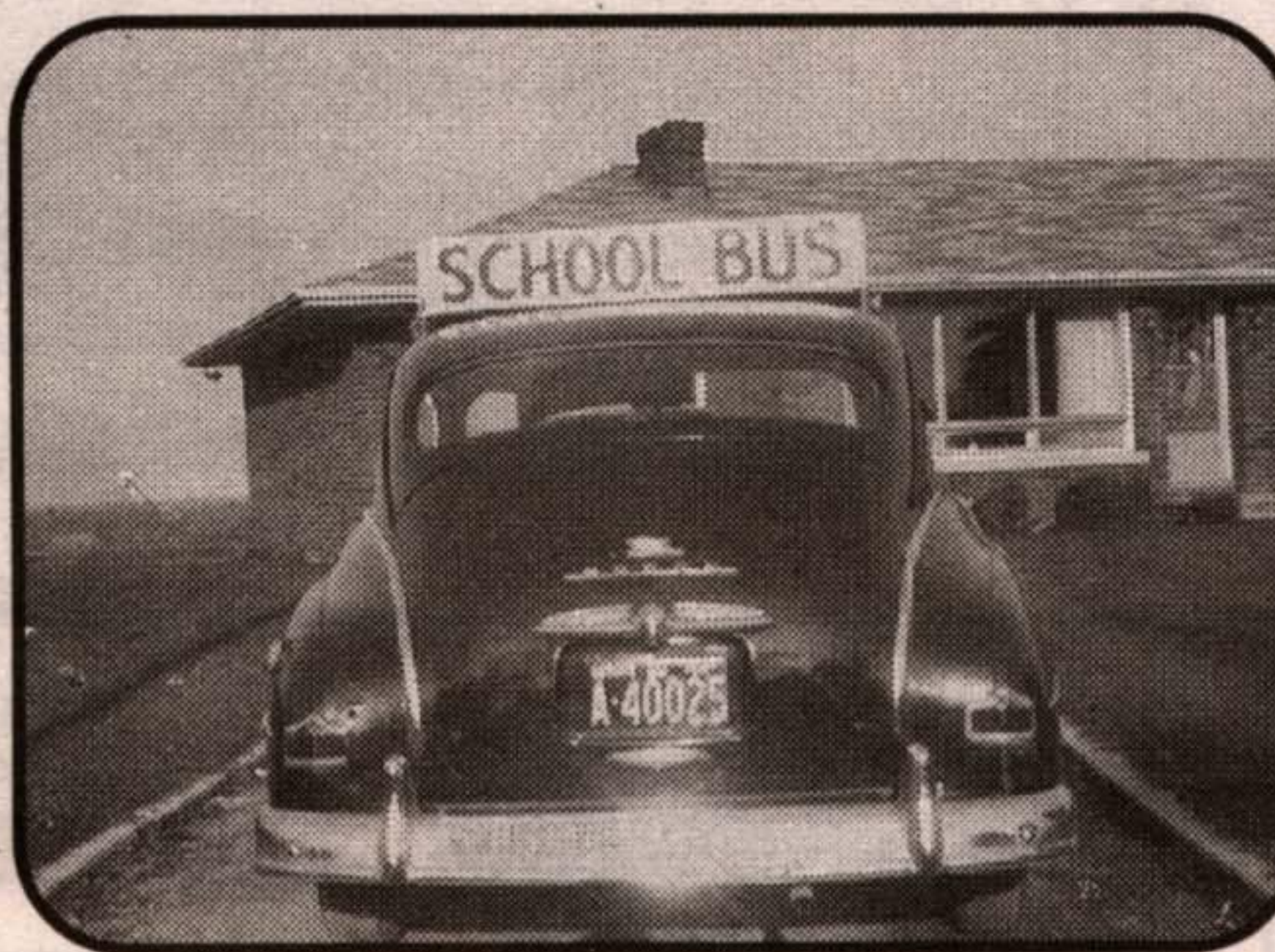
C.S. Denny Transport
