working part-time at a golf course for some extra cash flow.

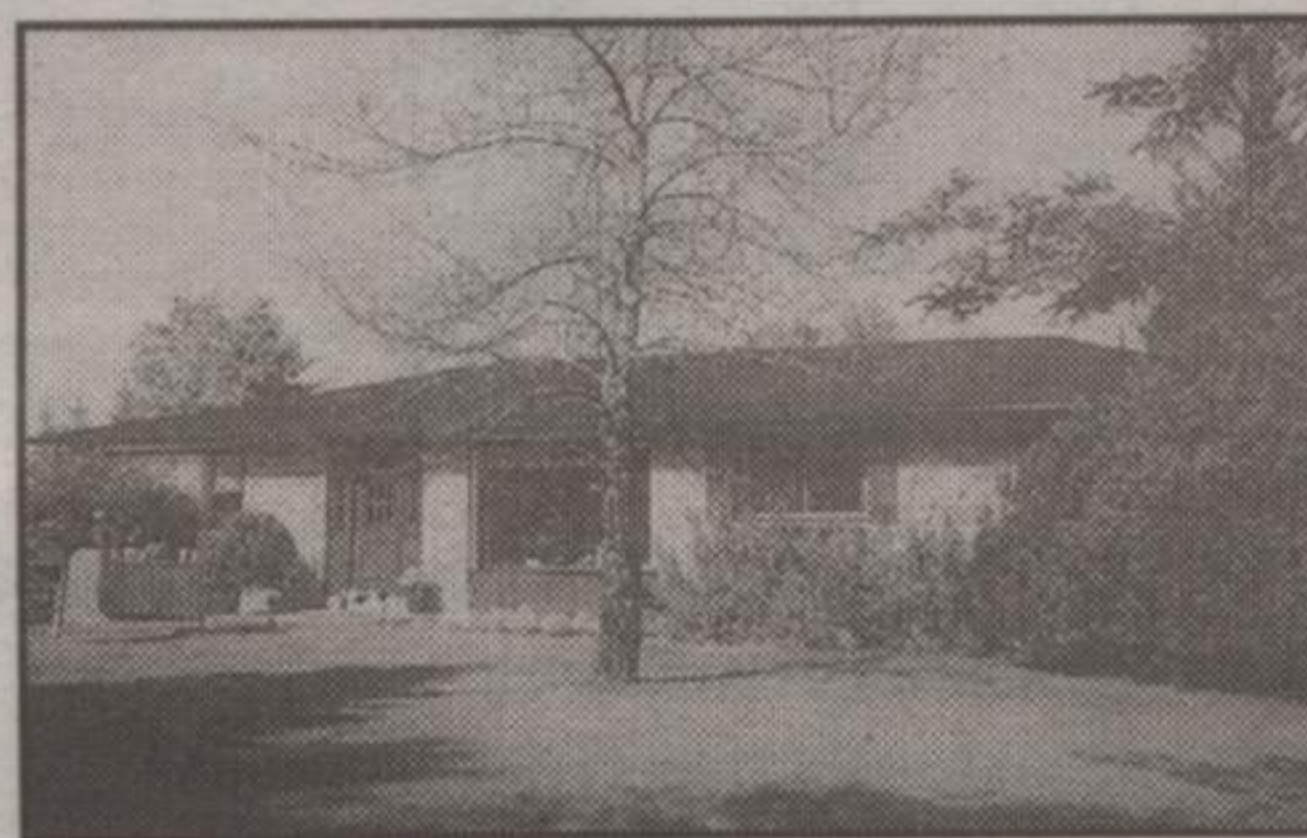
It seems the "M" of MRK Communications, the really big boss, thinks she's financed my little venture long enough!
