



The renovations include all three floors of the Alexander Barn to create exhibit, educational and rental space, and two floors of the Visitor Centre to provide archives, gift shop, and administration areas.

The Museum renovations have been under consideration since 1983 and can now begin with the recent approval of a construction tender in the amount of \$1.87 million to Struct-Con Construction Ltd. by Halton Regional Council. Work is targeted for completion by September 2001.


