Transportation, health, education and preserving and maintaining services and quality of life were high priorities. The restructuring of local government was very low in priority for Halton residents. On

March 30, The Greater Toronto Services Board will be meeting to complete its review and determine which of the four options it will be presenting to the provincial government on April 20. Chairman

Savoline intends to keep on defending Halton from falling prey to options two, giving the GTSB planning control over Halton, three, moving all Regional Services to the GTSB, or four, that of a directly elected GTSB Council.

"You the citizens and businesses of Halton have not been consulted. The GTSB can only make a recommendation to the Minister of Municipal Affairs on its future. It will up to the Province to decide whether or not to implement these recommendations. I encourage you to become involved in this issue and speak directly to your MPPs and to support your Mayor and me on this issue."




