



1819. Thomas purchased the west half of Lot 4, Conc. 7, Esquesing, in partnership with nes Cathedral, York, he married Eliza Ward of Islington who had come from County ught the east half of lot 5. He and John Taylor, in 1837, struck an agreement to split the ks of the stream and farmed a string hundred. Thomas and Elizabeth raised a family of in Trafalgar and later Michigan. Mary Ann married Abraham Procter and settled near gnes and farmed the homestead. Thomas II married Isabella and farmed on the 4th Line nd later Manitoba. John Ward was a drover first, then established the "Islington Hotel" farther south but north of Glenorchey. Abraham married Margaret Howson of Hornby iza and William Sr. are buried in a family cemetery on the farm. Joseph and Thomas II oard of the Milton Methodist N. C. Church Circuit. He was a trustee when Ashgrove James Arthurs. After his death she married James Gunn and moved to Buffalo. Thomas hen he went with some of his family to Manitoba.
