


Brookville Public School: Andrew Basso

Williams Glen Public School: Emily Dobson




Limehouse Public School: Ashley Nixon

rookville was struck by Dtragedy nearly a year ago when five year old Sarah Boucher lost her life after being hit by a car. Her mother, Deneen Campbell-Boucher, would like to take steps to make sure no other family goes through the anguish her family has suffered.
