Friends Program Returns to Brookville School

Brookville Public School will commence its third year of the "Friends" program this fall. This is a volunteer program that pairs children who would benefit from a one-to-one relationship, with a supportive friend. This relationship helps develop the child's self-esteem and fosters social growth, while having the child remain in the regular school system. Volunteers help students talk about their feelings and their relationships with peers, recognize their abilities, and generally "feel good" about themselves and their accomplishments.

Parent and community members are invited to volunteer and help with this program. The only requirement is to spend an hour each week with a child needing some special time with someone who cares. The child chooses an activity to do with the volunteer during the hour. The activity is not meant to be academically oriented, although it is done during school time and on school premises.

Men in the community are especially encouraged to consider this opportunity. There are a number of older male students who would benefit greatly from this companionship.
