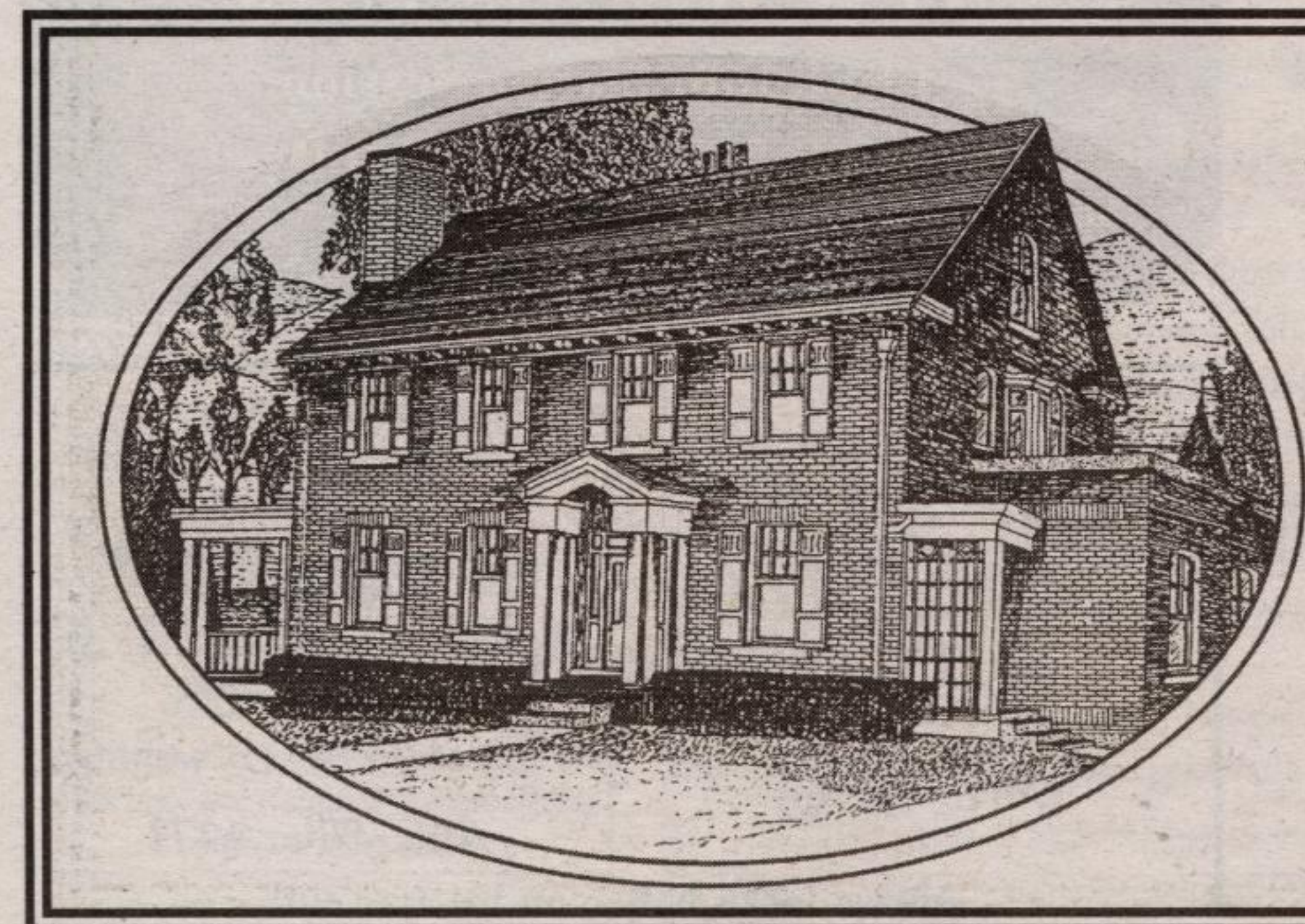
NOBLETT, Sarah "Chriss"
