# FoalQuest finds homes for more than 400 "at risk" foals

good home isn't always easy to find, especially for PMU (Pregnant Mares' Urine) foals, that are often found homeless, ownerless and being shipped off to meat auctions.

But there are people making a difference - a big difference.

FoalQuest Ltd., International organization based in Alberta, has found homes across North America for more than 400 PMU foals since 1999.

Since 1942, estrogen has been extracted from the urine of pregnant mares on PMU ranches for the production of replacement therapy medications. Premarin® is the most widely prescribed drug in the world, providing hormone treatment for over 10 million North American women each year.

The organization works with PMU producers to assure that as many foals as possible can be placed in caring homes rather than going to feedlots.

PMU ranches are located in Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, and North Dakota, and together produce approximately 34,000 foals each year. Unfortunately, approximately 32 per cent of all PMU foals will be sold to feedlots where they will be fed, slaughtered and sold overseas for human consumption.

These are the foals that FoalQuest is interested in helping. These are sound, healthy, well bred foals that have endless potential if just given the chance. FoalQuest is trying to promote these at risk foals so they can find caring homes.

Each spring, members of FoalQuest travel to PMU ranches in Alberta to take photographs of the foals. These photos are then displayed on their web site. Approved adopters are able to choose the foals they want from these pictures.

After the foals are weaned in September, they are taken to a central Alberta farm where they are checked by a veterinarian, dewormed and cared for by

FoalQuest volunteers until they are ready to travel to their new homes across Canada and the US.

For the past two years an Acton farm has provided a drop off area for the foals upon arrival in Halton and has agreed to do so again this year.

FoalQuest Ltd. is not an animal rights, political or activist group, they do not condemn the producers who make their living raising these foals and are not attempting to shut the industry down. Instead, FoalQuest works alongside the producers and NAERIC (North American Equine Ranching Information Council, in a joint effort to educate the public about these foals and to give them a chance to reach their true potential.
