



#### NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS **WEED CONTROL**

THE ONTARIO WEED CONTROL ACT AS IT APPLIES TO PERSONS IN POSSESSION OF LAND WITHIN THE TOWN OF HALTON HILLS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that unless noxious weeds are destroyed by June 10, 2002 and as often as is necessary throughout the season to prevent the ripening of their seeds and the dispersal of their pollens, the Town of Halton Hills may enter private property and destroy these weeds. The costs will be charged against the property owner and collected in the manner of municipal taxes.

For information of all property owners, the following are designated as noxious weeds in the Town of Halton Hills:

**Bull Thistle** Canada Thistle Colt's Foot Common Barberry Cypress Spurge Dodder European Buckthorn Goat's Beard Johnson Grass Knapweed Wild Carrot Yellow Rocket

**Nodding Thistle** Poison Hamlock Poison Ivy Proso Millet, Black-seeded Ragweed` Russian Thistle Scotch Thistle Sow Thistle **Tuberous Vetchling** Leafy Spurge Milkweed

Complaints regarding dandelion and golden road will not be accepted as these are not considered noxious weeds pursuant to the Weed Control Act.

## Remembering an angel

will never, ever forget about you, Sarah," was the message Brookville School Principal Rick Nodwell and his students extended to the family of Sarah Boucher at a memorial assembly held on Thursday, May 16.

Sarah had just entered kindergarten at Brookville last September when she lost her life after being hit by a car. Her legacy however, will live on in the creation of a memorial garden at the front entrance to Brookville Public School.

The garden, which will contain plaques commemorating the lives of Sarah Boucher and Carey Moore, who was killed in an airplane crash last year, was designed by Kelly MacIntyre, (along with many other parents and students), volunteered her time and labour to create a serene place of memory.

"It was such a wonderful feeling to create such a quiet place," Mrs. MacIntyre said.

It was so thoughtful of the

school to create this garden in memory of this little girl, who had been such a part of the school, Mrs. MacIntyre added.

Designed as a quiet place of reflection, the garden features a bench, waterfall, goldfish and a statue of a small girl reading a book.

The garden is designed to bloom in the spring and again in the fall, when students are in the school, and all the flowers are in Sarah's favourite colours - pink and

"I feel close to Sarah here," said Sarah's mother Dineen Campbell. "You'll probably see me here quite a bit on the weekends."

"This is part of the healing process for our school and our community," said Mr. Nodwell of the memorial assembly, as Brookville students Lisa Tuff, Lindsay Moniz, Elizabeth Demetrious and Ryan Bauer, (along with Mrs. MacIntyre, Milton District High School, student Steven Demetrious and Mademoiselle Domenich), lifted

their voices in song as a tribute to Sarah.

A reverential mood was set with renditions of "I Will Remember You" and "In The Arms of An Angel", before parents and students were asked to join in the singing of "Brown Eyed Girl" and "Let It Be".

"This is beautiful," said Sarah's father Duncan Boucher. "Thank you for all the work you've put into it. Thank you for all the support and friendship you showed Sarah.'

Mr. Boucher paused to fight back tears before delivering one more message to the students of Brookville School.

"Sarah was always happy and willing to help someone else and I hope that you'll all continue that in your lives."


