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NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS DESTROY NOXIOUS WEEDS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all persons in possession of land, in accordance with The Weed Control Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter W.5, Sections 3, 13, 14, 16 and 23 that, unless weed seeds and noxious weeds growing on their lands within the Town of Milton are destroyed by the date of June 15th, 2002 and throughout the season, the Town of Milton may enter upon the said lands and have the weeds destroyed, charging the costs against the land in taxes as set out in The Weed Control Act.

The co-operation of all property owners is earnestly solicited. Complaints and inquiries may be made by telephone, to the number listed below. Please note that dandelions, burdock and goldenrod are not considered noxious weeds within the Town of Milton under The Weed Control Act; therefore, complaints concerning these weeds or any anonymous complaints cannot be accepted.

For information of all property owners, the following are designated as noxious weeds in the Town of Milton:

PRE-AUTHORIZED TAX PAYMENT PROGRAM (PTP) JOIN NOW FOR THE 2002 FINAL BILLING

The Town of Milton has expanded the existing PTP program to accept enrollment application mid year. **Enroll between May 01 and June 13, 2002, and have your final 2002 taxes withdrawn automatically.** Due to time constraints, applications not received by June 13, 2002 will not be eligible to participate until 2003.

Applications will be mailed to you with your final tax bill (early June), or you are most welcome to pick up an application at the Corporate Services counter at 43 Brown St., Milton, or fill out the application form below. Don't forget that a void cheque must accompany all applications, and only accounts that are a) fully assessed (both land and house value) and b) paid up to date, will be accepted into this program.

Two programs to choose from

- Monthly Plan: 10 withdrawals per year, the first business day of each month, February to November
Due Date Plan: 4 yearly withdrawals, on the last business day of February, April, June and September
