






Fisher Family Tree

Tohn Fisher, a carpenter by trade, wife Agnes Ovens and son George came from Roxboroughshire, Scotland, to the United States, probably in 1917. It is believed that they lived with, or near, Agnes' sister at Buffalo. Daughters Jane and Mary were born in the United States. John came to Upper Canada and on July 1, 1819, he and Abraham Neilson, who had emigrated from the same area, petitioned for land grants. John received the east half of Lot 9, Con. 5 Esquesing, and Abraham received Lot 10, Con. 6. They worked on their properties and returned to Buffalo to work for the winter. Son George died in 1818. Daughter Jane married Thomas Hume and they farmed on the west half of Lot 12, Con. 4. He was the Scotch Block postmaster. In 1884 they moved to Walkerton. Mary married Alexander Hume and farmed on the George Hume homestead at Lot 11, Con. 2. John went to Kincardine in Bruce County. Thomas married Margaret Michie. They farmed the west half of Lot 9, Con 6. Their daughter Agnes married John Chisholm and farmed the east half of Lot 4, Con. 1, north of the village of Peru. Agnes married Joseph Brownridge. Their son John Fisher Brownridge took over the Brownridge homestead at Lot 4, Con 7 (Trafalgar Rd). Murray Brownridge, his wife Carol and sons farm there today. Isabella married Thomas Brownridge. They farmed at the Boyne, south of Milton. Georgina married George Brownridge. They went to Western Manitoba and farmed near Miniota. Eliza married Neil

They were dedicated members of Boston Presbyterian Church. Their children were: Dr. John Fisher D.V.M. of Brandon, Manitoba. He married Dora Rowe and had sons Robert, Fred, Rowe and Glen; Dr. Peter Miller Fisher D.V.M. married Florence Dick, lived at Lot 8, Con. 5, later moving to Toronto. Their son Dr. Stuart Fisher M.D. practiced in Northern Ontario and Quebec. Mary (Minnie) married Walter Lawson Sr. of Stewarttown. They had a grist mill. Walter Jr. married Flora Pedden. He and
