PUBLIC NOTICE

Halton Region is currently undertaking a five-year review of the Regional Official Plan (1995). A major component of Halton's Official Plan is the identification of Halton's natural heritage areas, collectively referred to as the Greenlands System, and the development of policies for their protection.

As part of the Official Plan Review, Halton Region has undertaken studies to update the boundaries of the Greenlands System and is proposing the addition of "Significant Woodlands" to the system as required by the Provincial Policy Statement issued by the Province of Ontario under *The Planning Act*. The study results are documented in four Draft Technical Background Papers. These papers and the staff report (PPW97-02) are available for the public to review and provide comments:

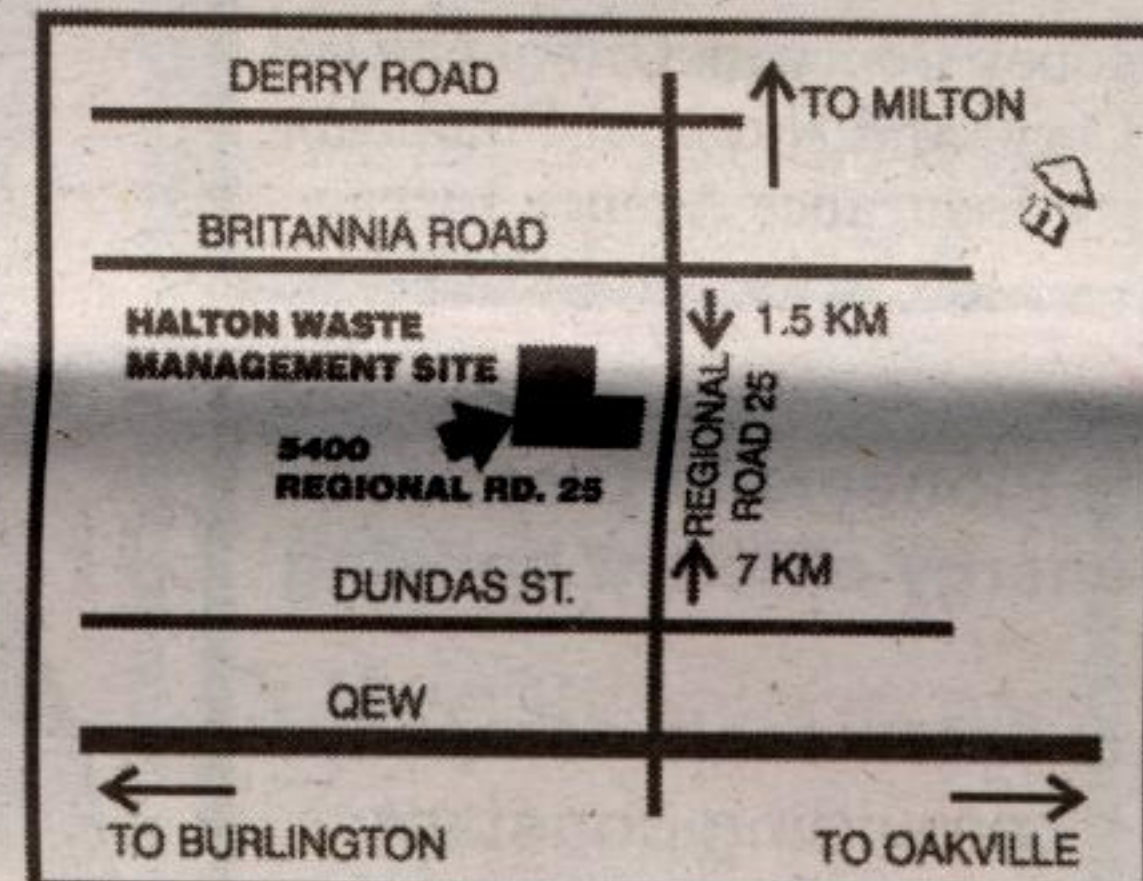

- Composting
- Vacuum collection program (where offered by your area municipality)

Enjoy the fruits of your labour.

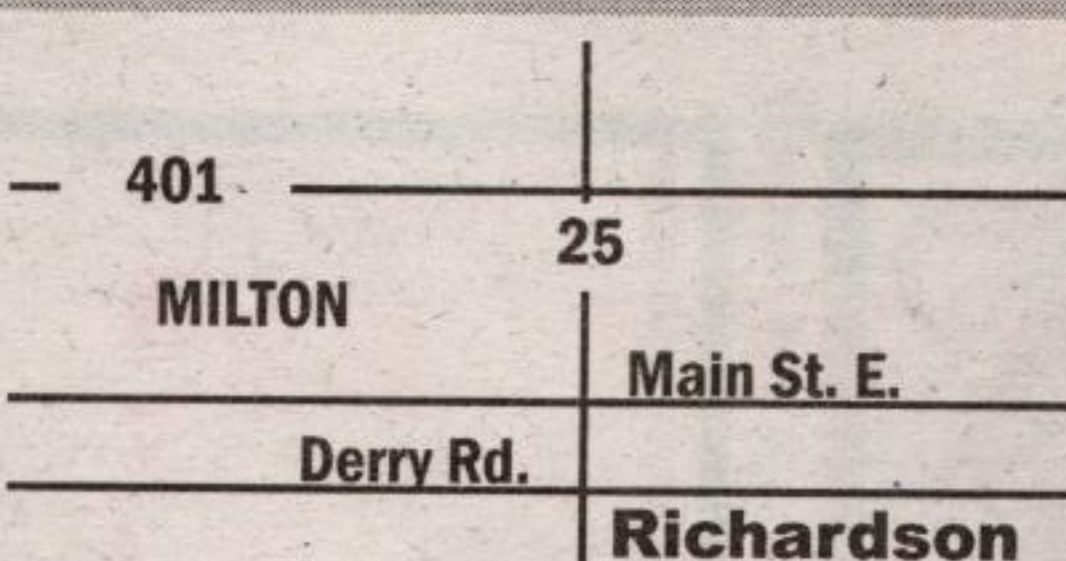
