Advisory Committee) requested "that Halton Region take the lead role in focusing its own and Conservation Halton's resources on a co-coordinated plan for monitoring, investigation, sharing data related to ground and surface water, and source control; such that, in co-operation with landowners, problems can be identified and sustainable solutions found."

When information is conducted separately (by both the Halton Region and Conservation Halton) it is often incompatible due to the complexity of water, therefore this request will enable Halton Region's Aquifer Management Plan and the various Conservation Halton watershed studies to complement each other. This request would also aid Conservation Halton in their strategic direction of planning not monitoring conservation efforts within the watershed so that, with the cooperation of the Ministry of Environment and Energy, real conservation can be achieved.

HAAC is looking to Halton Region for their active input in managing the watershed in conjunction with Conservation Halton's long term strategic plan focused on creating and maintaining a healthy watershed. If the Region of Halton helped with the maintenace and monitoring of the plan then Conservation Halton would be able to conduct the studies necessary for the understanding of our water system and thus the solution to our problems.








