




Leading the way for Santa

Katie Patterson (Milton Fair Ambassador) greeted many onlookers as she was chauffeured through the Milton Santa Claus Parade route on November 23.








Happy Birthday!

- Tarion Diamond and Isobelle McLean cut the cake after a service of cel-LV Lebration and thanksgiving was held at Ebenezer United Church on October 27 to mark the 179th Anniversary of their congregation and to rejoice that, as of December 2001, all funds borrowed for a major addition project have been discharged.

Lt. Co. The Rev. Cennis Dwyer of Owl's Head Mountain in Quebec's Eastern Townships was guest speaker. As part of the service, a ceremony, led by Michael Sutherland, assisted by Doyle Prier, former minister now retired, and Roy Metcalfe, chair of the Building Committee, was performed to give thanks to God and loyal friends for a debt free house of worship, followed by the symbolic burning of the mortgage and the singing of the doxology.

Construction to virtually double the size of Ebenenzer Church took place in 1991. The members of the day had a vision to provide a more spacious, functional and modern facility for its members and for community use in general. They agreed the current facility, although adequate for worship services, would not meet the expectations of the next generation and of the residents who are currently living or moving into our community. The courageous decision to build the addition has proved to be sound. With the Grace of God, and the sacrifice and generosity of the many friends of Ebenezer the debt was retired in half the time envisioned.

The following weekend the annual Roast Beef Dinner was held. Over 300 people came to socialize with their neighbours and enjoy a delicious dinner with all the trimmings.
