Footprints tells of the journeys of over 30 people who found their way

to Canada. Park Public School's grade five students interviewed each of these people as part of their Social Studies curriculum.

These fascinating stories of leaving home countries behind, emigrating to Georgetown and starting over, all are divided into four sections :Africa, Asia, Europe and North America. Each charming vignette is as much about multiculturism as it is about the journey through the emigration process.


