within the study. "They're taking a narrow look at how people and goods will be moving in 30 years, and they're only looking at building roads. This will put pressure on rural areas to expand. A lot of this land runs through rural areas where there is not a lot of need for transit unless urban sprawl occurs."

The proposed Mid-Peninsula Corridor has also come under fire from local citizens outraged at the possibility that the new highway might be a toll road.

The Region of Halton would like to see more time available for public input into the Terms of Reference. "Time is of the essence here," Oakville Regional Councillor John Taylor told Regional Council on February 12th. "The document that we have to deal with was only available from the Ministry on February 7th, and the deadline for input is March 17th." Regional staff presented a report to Council stating, "The time frame for reviewing the documents is inadequate to provide appropriate comments and allow Regional Council the opportunity to provide input."

Regional Council voted to draft a letter to the Ministry of Transportation to request an extension of the March 17th deadline to April 30th.

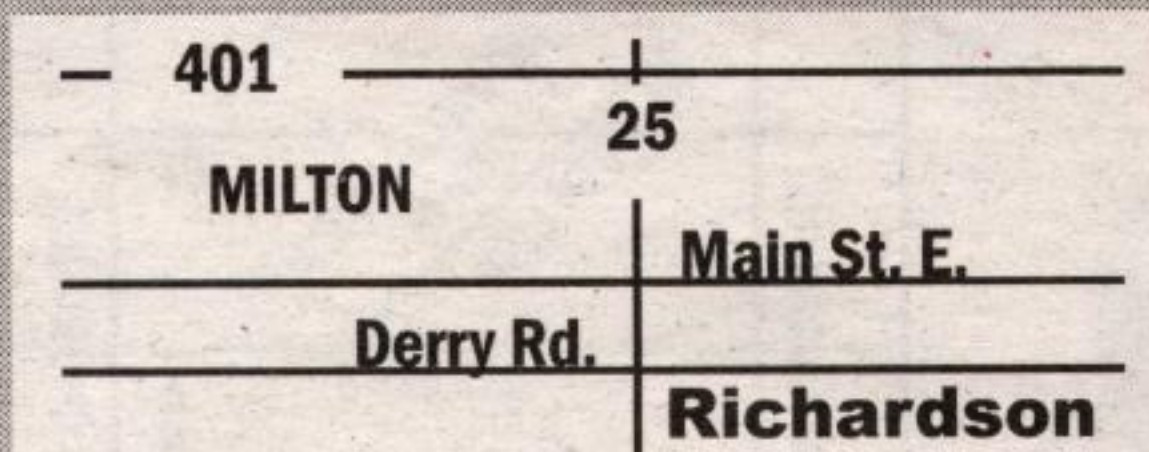
