





William Wright Scott married Rachel Arthurs in Guelph on July 6, 1870. Rach was the daughter of Irish immigrants, John Arthurs and Margaret Early, and was bor in Esquesing on January 6, 1851. William and Rachel raised 10 children on their farm located next to the Limehouse Presbyterian Church at Lot 23, Concession 6.
