Well it's back to school time, fair time, canning and preserving time, and much more. This September also brings a change for The Compass. I bought a new cookbook, no, I bought two – one for each of my granddaughters. It's called 365 Quick, Easy & Inexpensive Dinner Menus. The recipes are quite easy, and it is fun to check to see what's on the menu each day. Ground turkey seems quite popular now, and so this is a quick meal.

SWEET HONEY BBQ SANDWICHES

1 tablespoon oil
1 green pepper
1 medium onion, finely chopped
2 pounds ground turkey
1 cup stewed tomatoes, puréed
1 teaspoon celery seed
1/2 teaspoon chili powder
1 teaspoon salt or to taste
1/4 cup honey
1/4 cup brown sugar
2 tablespoons apple cider vinegar
2 teaspoons prepared mustard
(optional)

In a large skillet, heat oil and add green pepper, onion and ground turkey. Cook until meat is cooked through and vegetables are tender. Add puréed tomatoes, celery seed, chili powder, salt, honey, brown sugar and vinegar. Mix well. Cook for about 5 minutes over medium heat. Taste sauce. If it tastes too sweet, add 2 teaspoons prepared mustard and stir well. Continue simmering over low heat for about 10-15

minutes. Spoon mixture onto buns, and serve each with a slice of cheese and some dill pickles.

BAKED BEANS

This is an easy recipe for baked beans without all the hard work and long baking time.

2 large cans of pork 'n' beans
1 onion, finely chopped
½ cup ketchup
¾ cup brown sugar (or a little less)
1 tablespoon prepared mustard
1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce

Combine all in a casserole. Heat for 20 minutes.
