


MALBOEUF ANEW MAYOR FOR THENEW MILTON



Citizens of Milton,

Our town is changing; it is no longer the Milton of 30, 20 or even five years ago. The role of local government has also changed due to the Federal and Provincial Governments' downloading many of their responsibilities to Municipal and Regional Governments. A Mayor who understands the financial realities of today. A Mayor who is prepared to move forward in the areas of public safety and security. A Mayor who understands what the people of Milton want and expect from their elected officials. We need a Mayor who has the experience needed to deal with the challenges we face.

I believe I can be that Mayor. My six years on both Milton and Regional Councils, serving on many prominent committees, along with 30 years of business experience have provided me the knowledge I need to lead Milton in the years to come. To do so I need your support on Nov. 10th.


