INFORMATION FOR ELECTORS

You should have received your Voter Notification Card for the 2003 municipal and school board elections to be held November 10 from 10:00 am to 8:00 pm advising you where and when you may vote. READ THIS CARD as voting locations have changed significantly since the last election.

BRING THIS CARD WITH YOU TO VOTE

If you did not receive a card and wish to find out where you vote, please call 905-878-7252 ext 2130, 2131 or 2137 and bring ID with you to vote.

We encourage electors to vote at one of our advance polls November 1st from 10:00 am to 6:00 pm or November 5th from 10:00 am to 8:00 pm. BOTH WILL BE LOCATED AT MILTON MALL, 55 ONTARIO STREET IN MILTON. When you are doing your shopping, stop by to cast your vote on our new touch-screen voting machines! We will be located near Zellers.

Here are some general tips to keep in mind:

- Vote before 3:00 pm to avoid lineups.
- If you vote at a school it will be busy from 2:45 pm to 4:00 pm with students leaving for the day.
- Carpooling is strongly encouraged.

Answers to FAQ's...

- The onus is on the elector to only vote once in the Town of Milton election, however an elector can vote in more than one municipality if so qualified.
- The list of candidates is located on our website.
- You can be added to the voters' list at your voting location...it is not necessary to do this at Town Hall.
- If you receive a voter notification card for an elector who no longer resides at your address, please mark it as "moved - return to sender" and drop it in the mail.
- Results will be displayed on the Town's website on election night starting shortly after 8:00 pm. The results will be updated to our website as we receive them. We expect results from all polls to be posted by 9:00 pm.

It would be an honour to represent the people of Campbellville and rural Milton on Town of Milton Council.

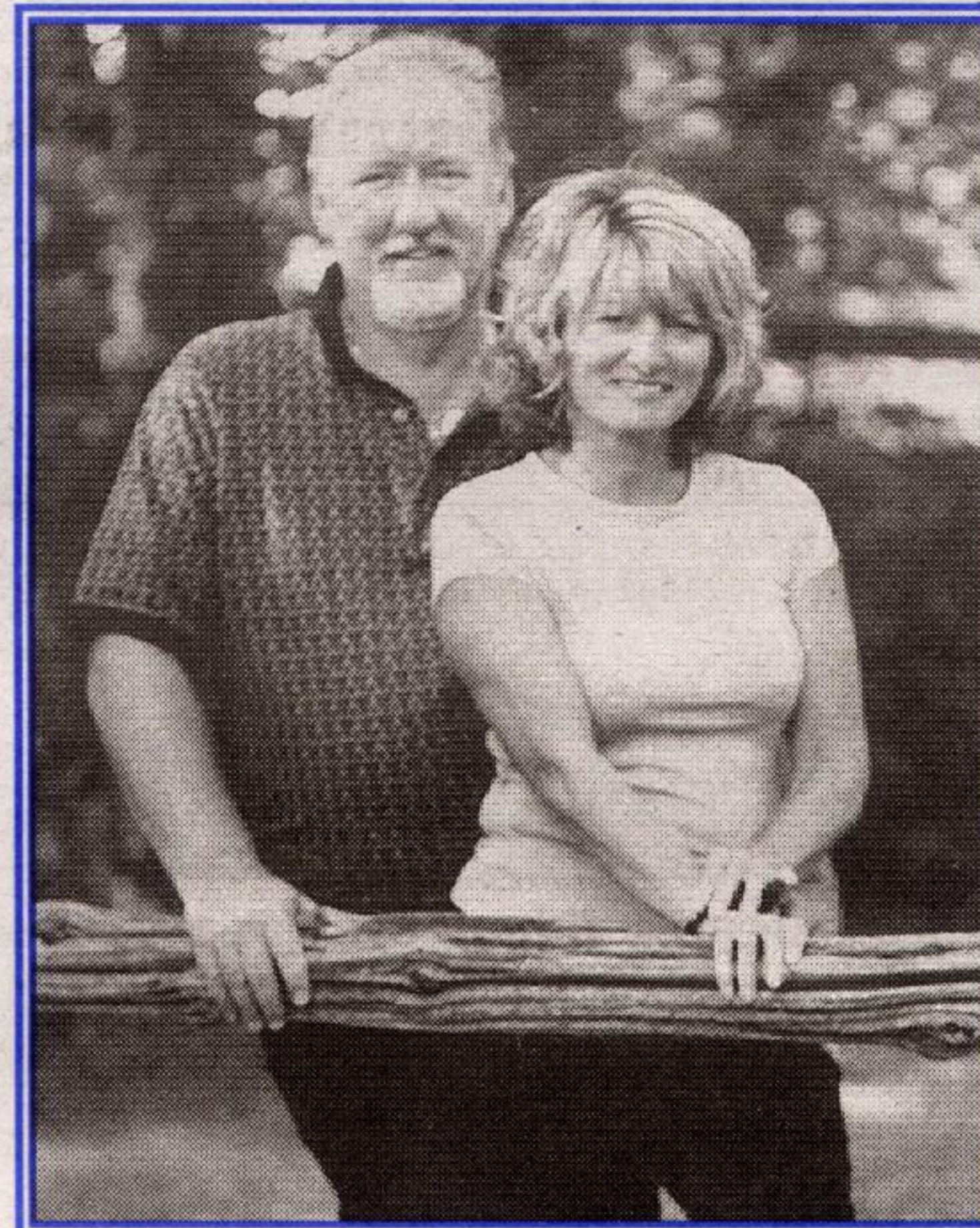
We are all fortunate to live in such a beautiful place as Ward 3, Milton.

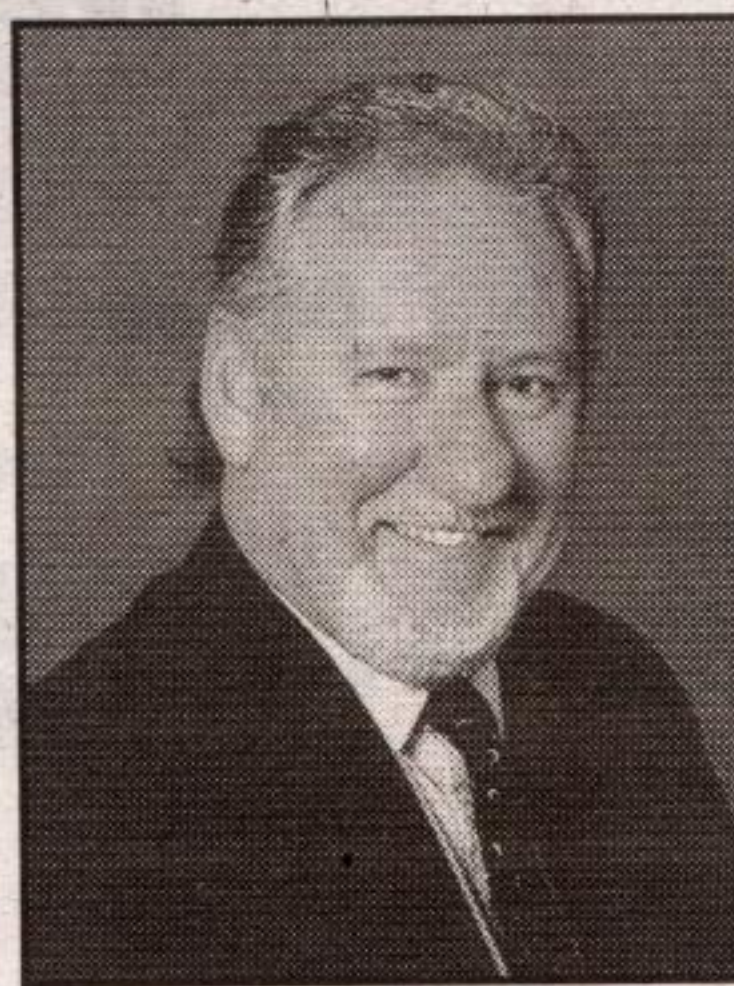
