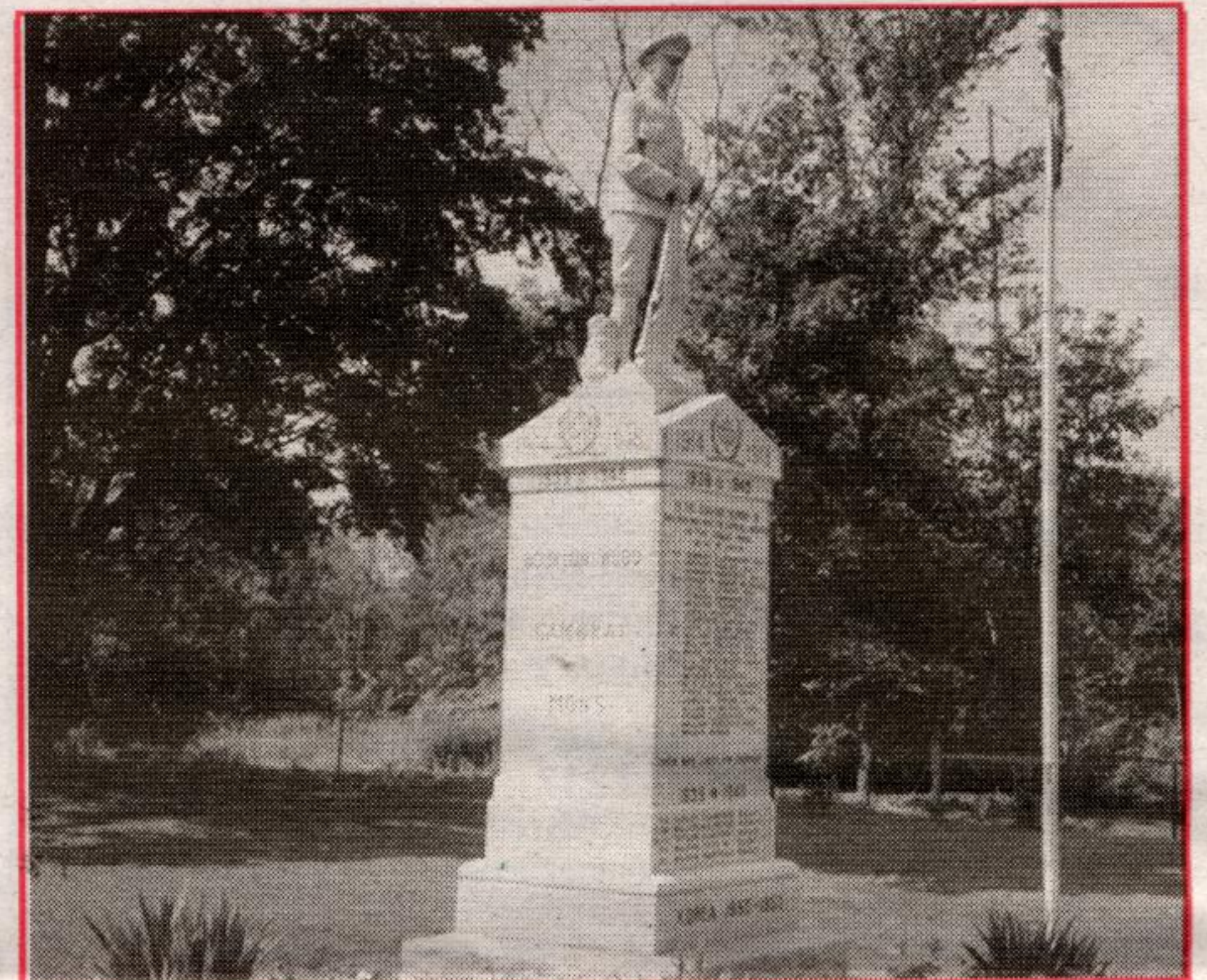

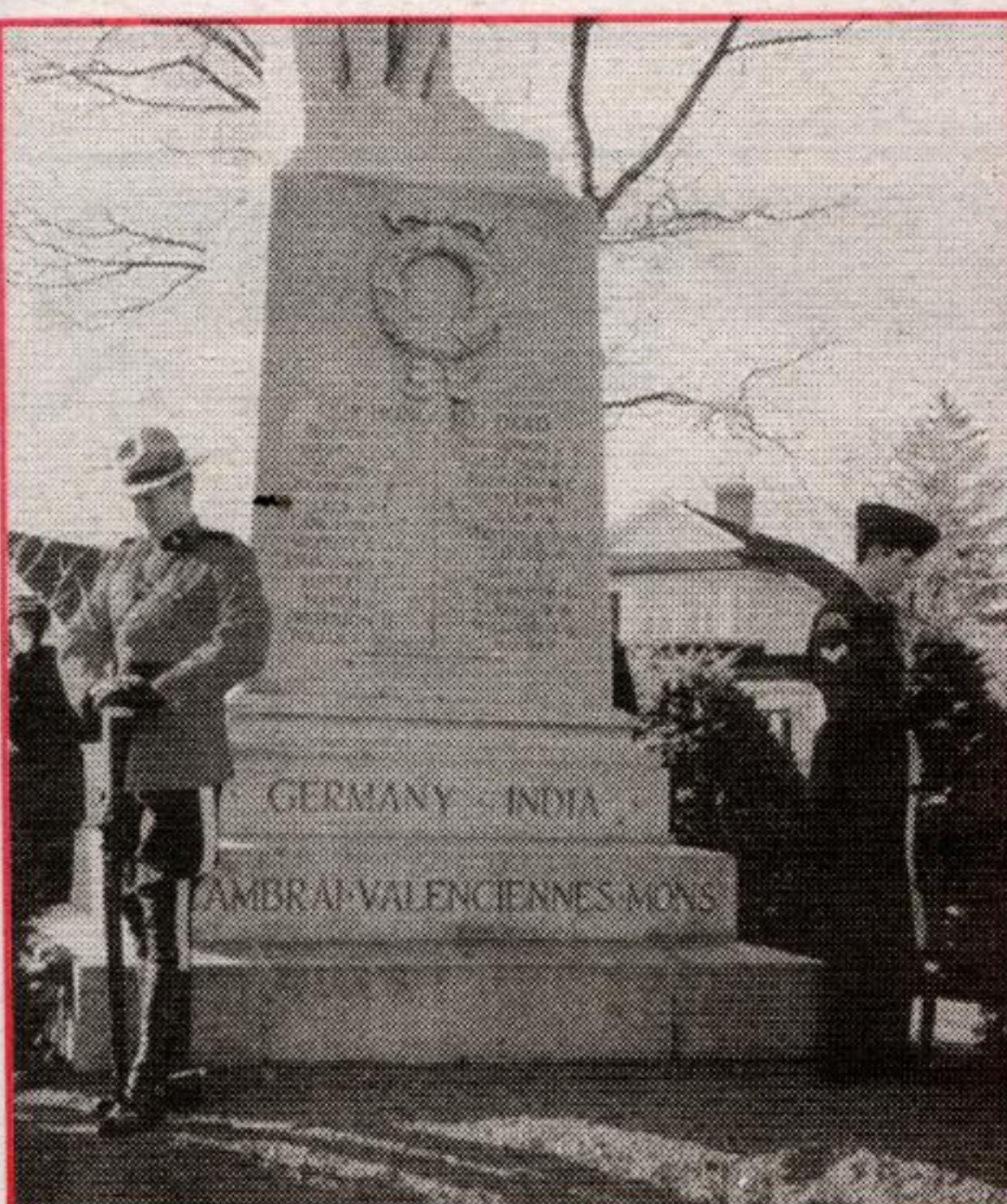
**Lieutenant Phillip Bainbridge, former schoolteacher,
