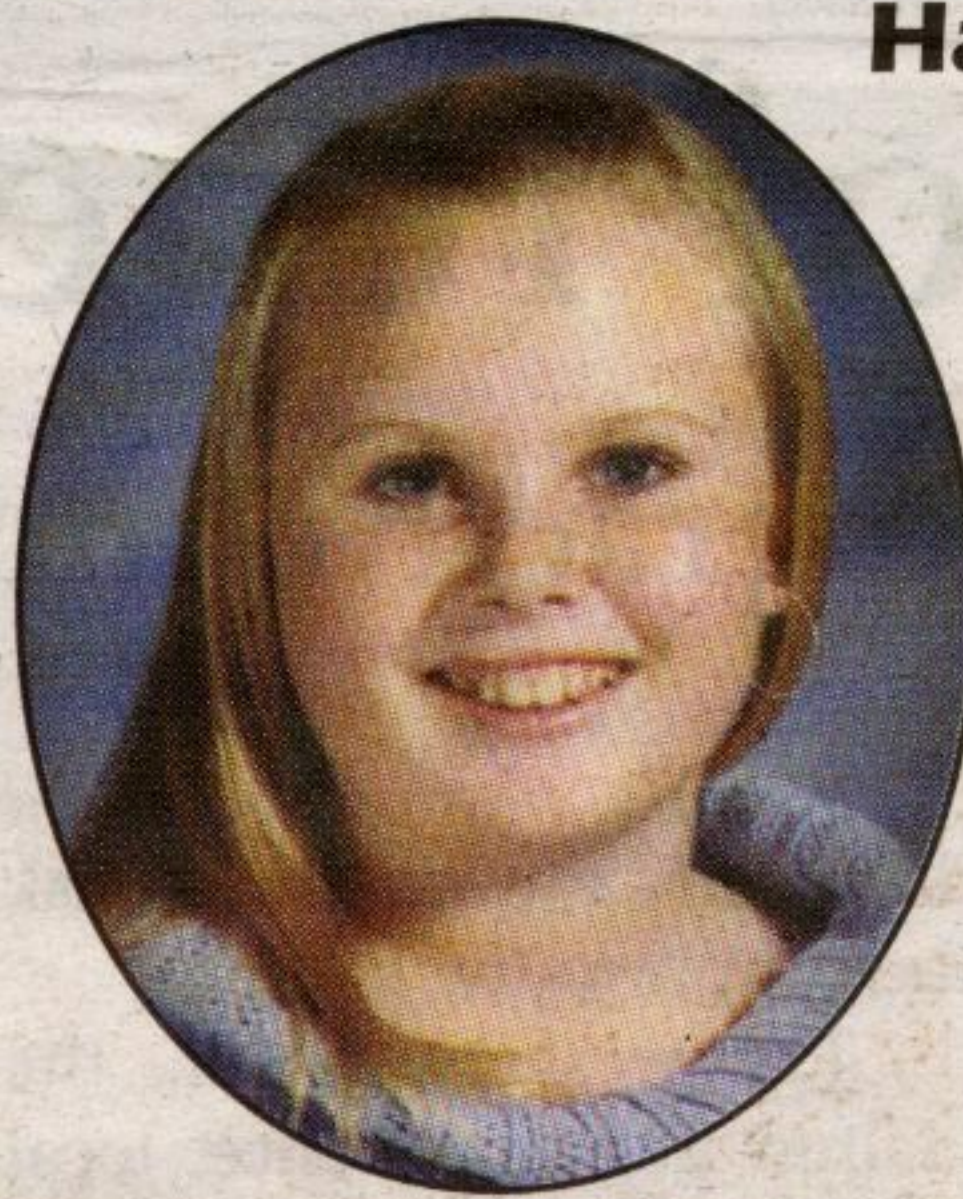

Lord of the Goblets

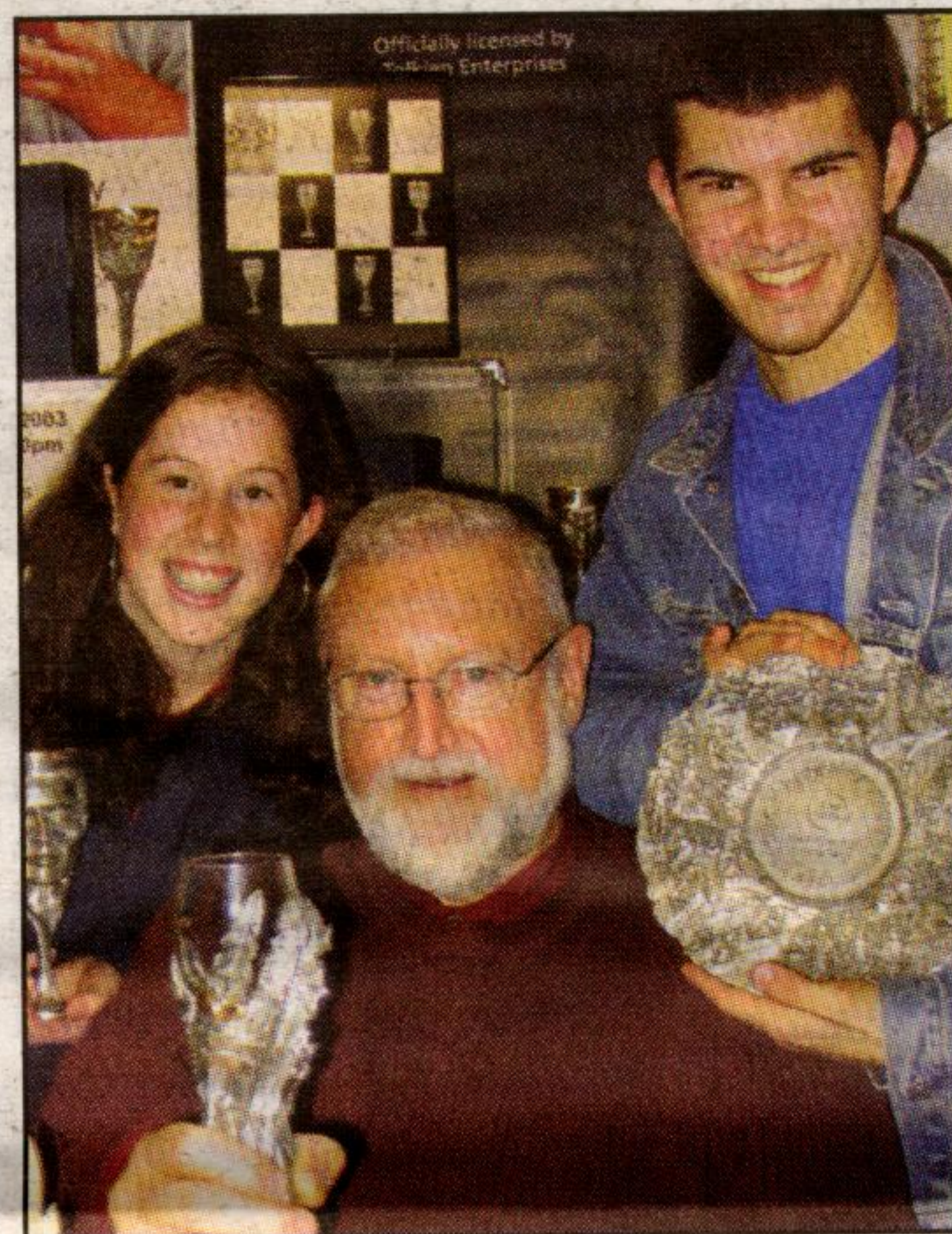

Winter Fantasy

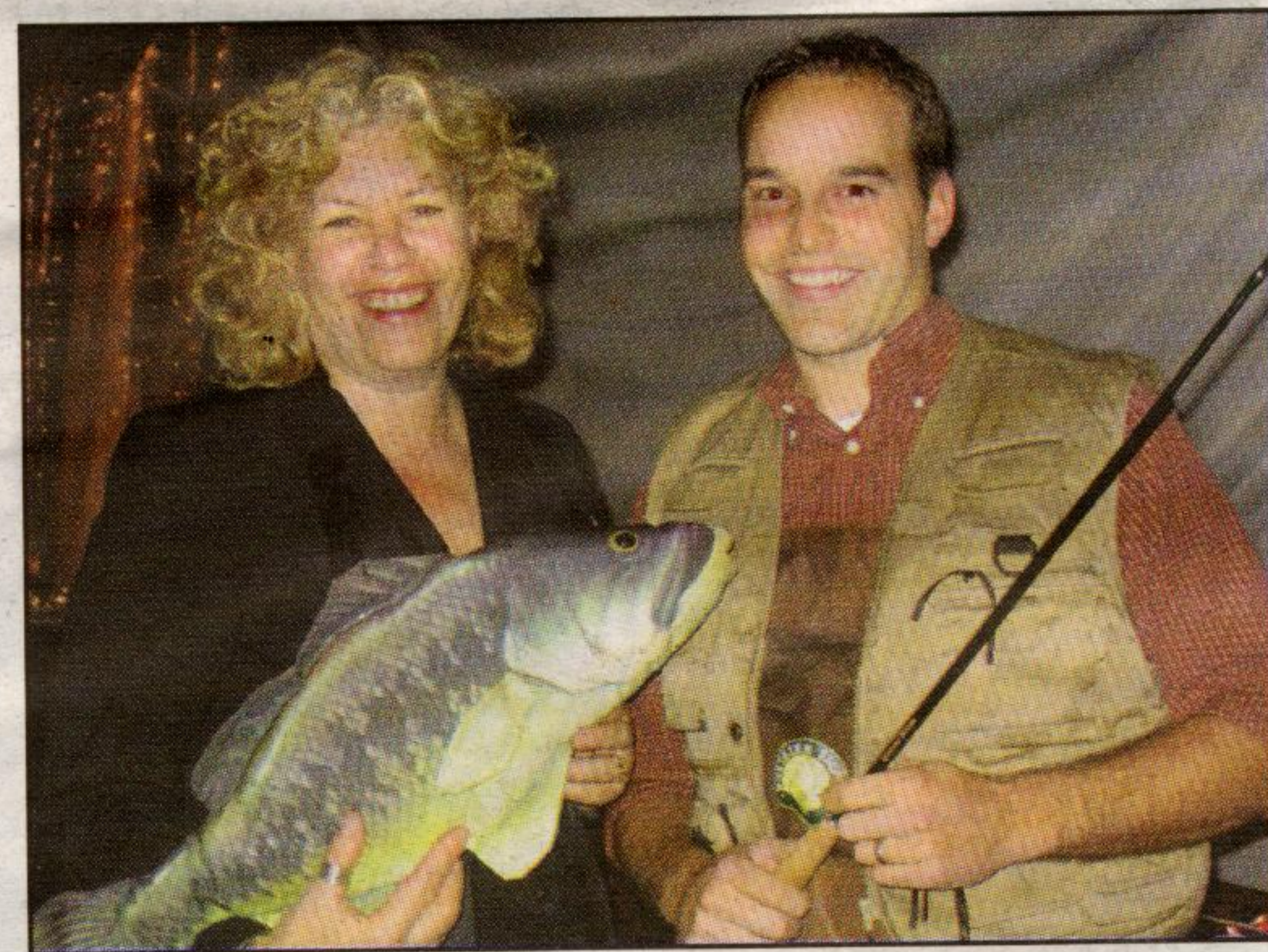
