Town of Milton launches new transit service

Free rides for the first five weeks

A s of August 16, the Town will be offering expanded transit service, which will include three fixed routes, scheduled bus stops approximately every 30 minutes from 6am to 8:30pm on weekdays and transfers between all routes at the Milton GO station. This new service will also provide secondary school students with considerably more

travel flexibility than the former Milton transit morning and afternoon high school bus routes, which have now been discontinued. To encourage residents to try the new service, all rides will be free of charge until regular fares begin on September 20, 2004. Fully accessible transit service for customers with disabilities remains unchanged.

Bus tickets and transit maps, which also indicate Town facilities, parks and walking trails, will be available at the Town Hall, Leisure Centre, Sports Centre, Seniors Activity Centre, Milton Public Library and the Lottery Kiosk at Zellers in the Milton Mall. Starting September 20, the cash fare will be \$2. Discounted tickets are also available in packages of 10. These packages cost \$14 6-18 children/students years of age, \$17.50 for

adults and \$12 for seniors. Children under 6 years of age ride free of charge. GO train commuters can ride Milton transit for 50 cents when they show their GO pass or ticket on their way to or from the GO station.

The Town has moved from the former Dial-a-bus system to the new fixed route service as a result of resident input and recommendations from the North Halton Transit Strategy Study. The new service is expected to better meet the travel demands of this growing community. To minimize start-up costs, the Town of Milton is pleased to be working in partnership with the Town of Oakville to offer this new service and will be using Oakville's smaller, commuter friendly buses. The Town will continue to assess the need for changes and enhancements to transit service. 
