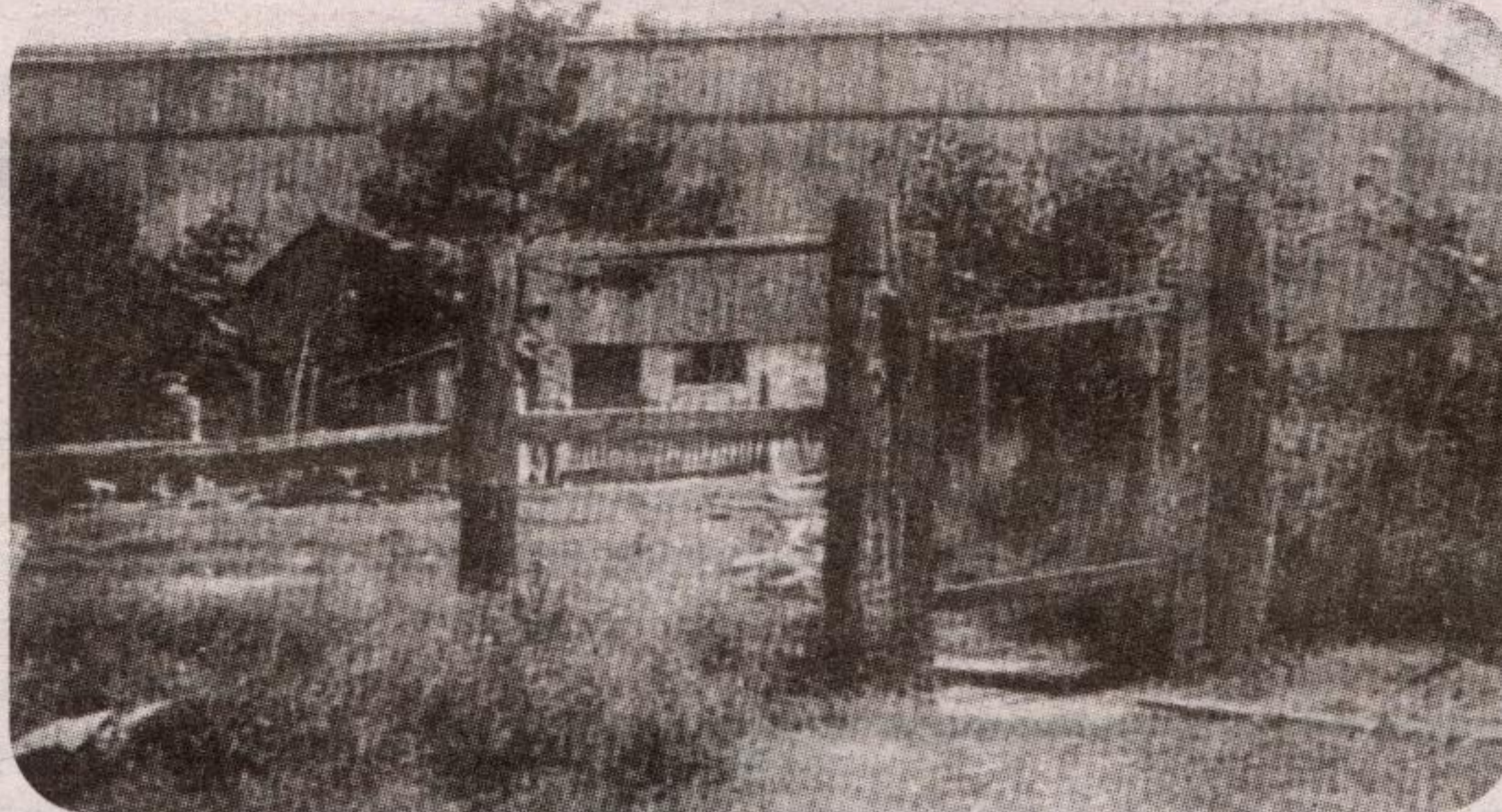

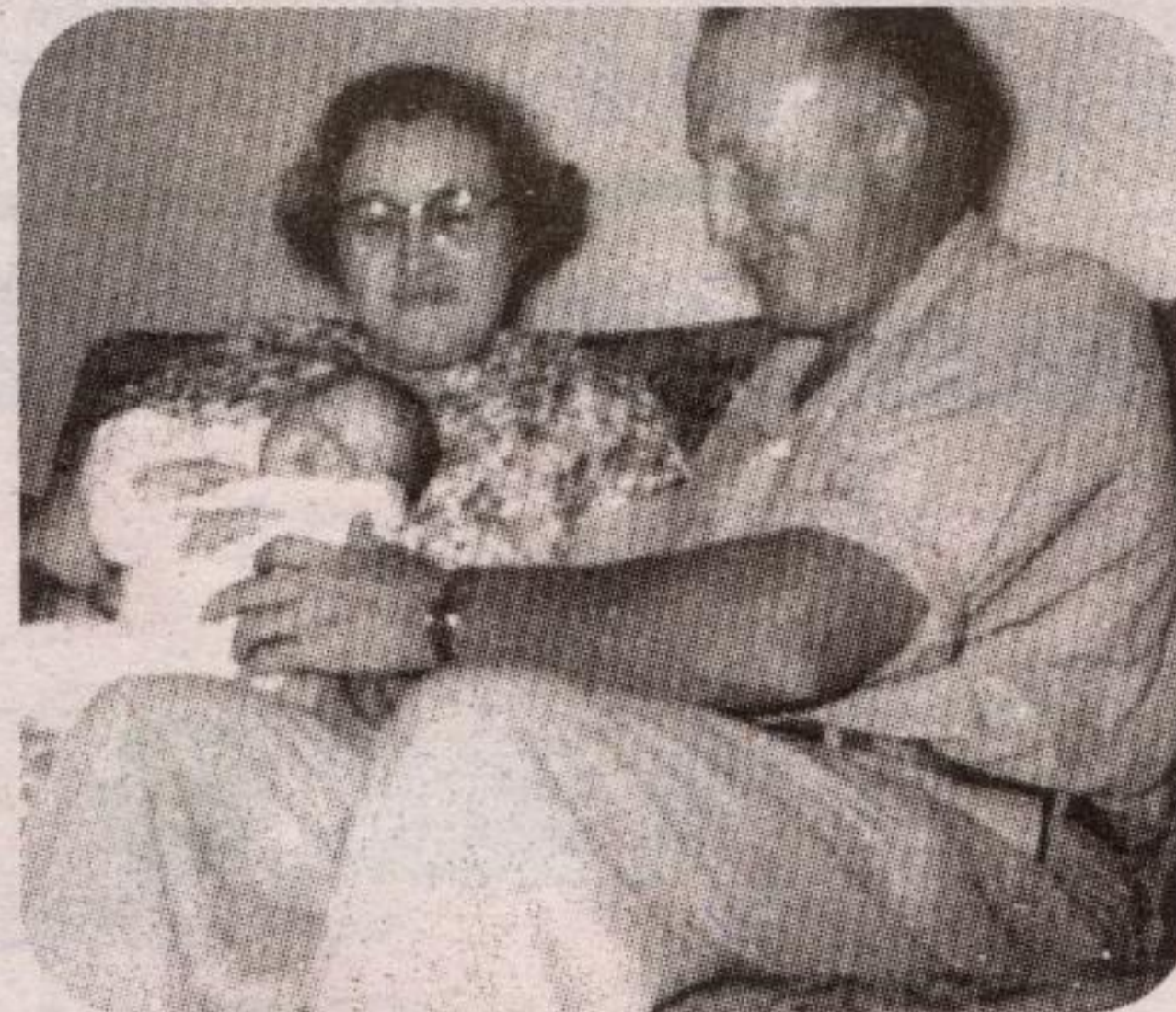

After his death Margaret married Norman Ross. He worked for Sanderson Memorial Stones in Orillia. They lived near Powasson then moved to Burke Falls where Margaret became a Librarian. Edward married Evelyn Peddie. He worked with his father, Elizabeth married Edward Bailey, and they were on the Halton School Board Janitorial Staff. They lived on Trafalgar Road south of Halton Rd. 9 before moving to Milton. Kathleen lives at Canmore, Alberta and manages a private campground. John (Jack) Irving married Flora MacLean. They were the first wedding in Boston Church, 1936. They farmed on Lot 7 con 2 Esquesing. He was a trustee of Ligny School. Teachers boarded at their home. The community enjoyed the garden parties held at their farm. They boarded construction workers who worked on Hwy. 25. Jack also was an elder at Boston being the third generation. They sold the farm and retired to Milton. They had two sons and two daughters. David worked for Clarence Cation in construction, George was a truck driver, and Marlene married Bill Pearson, and worked for Milton Hydro and Bill work for General Motors. Margot married Thomas Johnson. He works for the Steel Company in Milton and she is Supply Manager for Milton Hospital. Douglas married Hazel Green. She was a schoolteacher at Quatre Bras and later at Bruce Street School in Milton. Doug worked for the county after they sold the home farm to Clifford and Mary Brown. The descendants of the first George John Irving have been greatly involved in Boston Presbyterian Church. They have been and are great singers, adding much to their church service through their musical talents.
