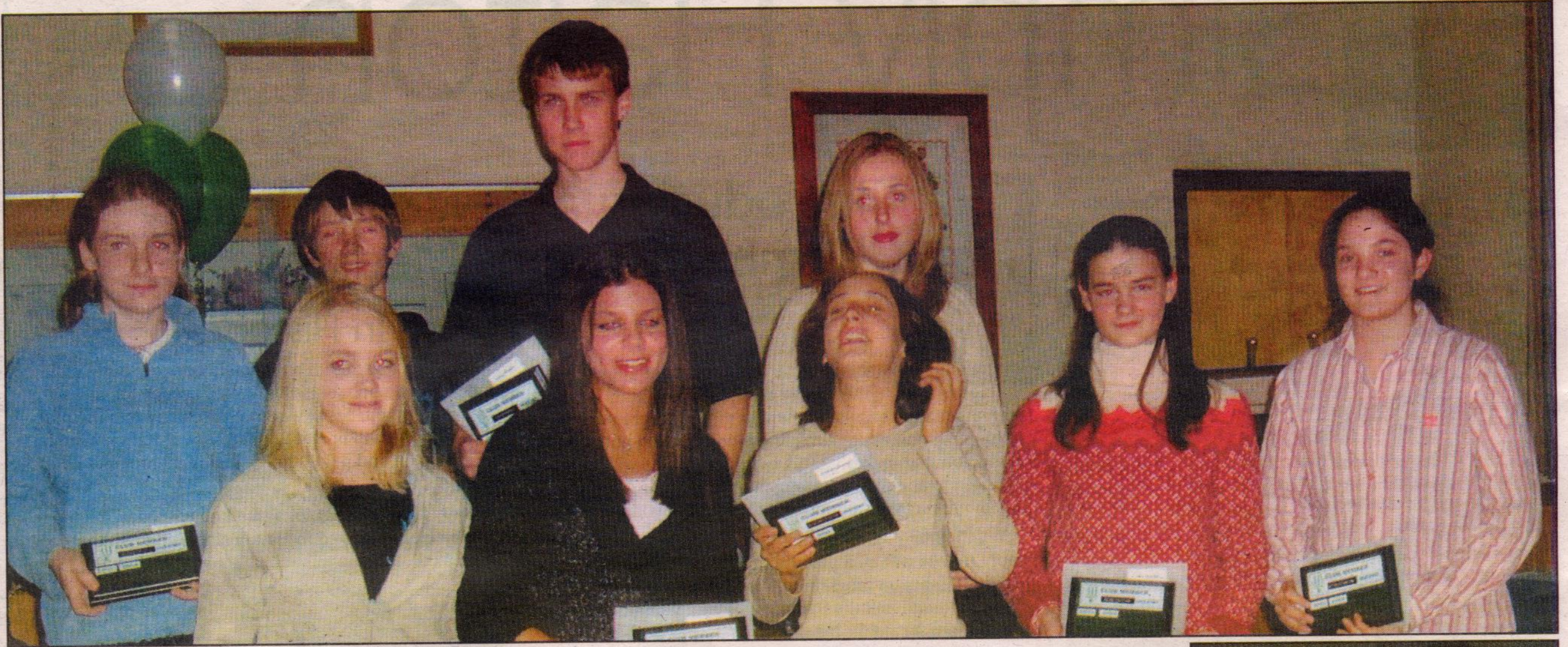
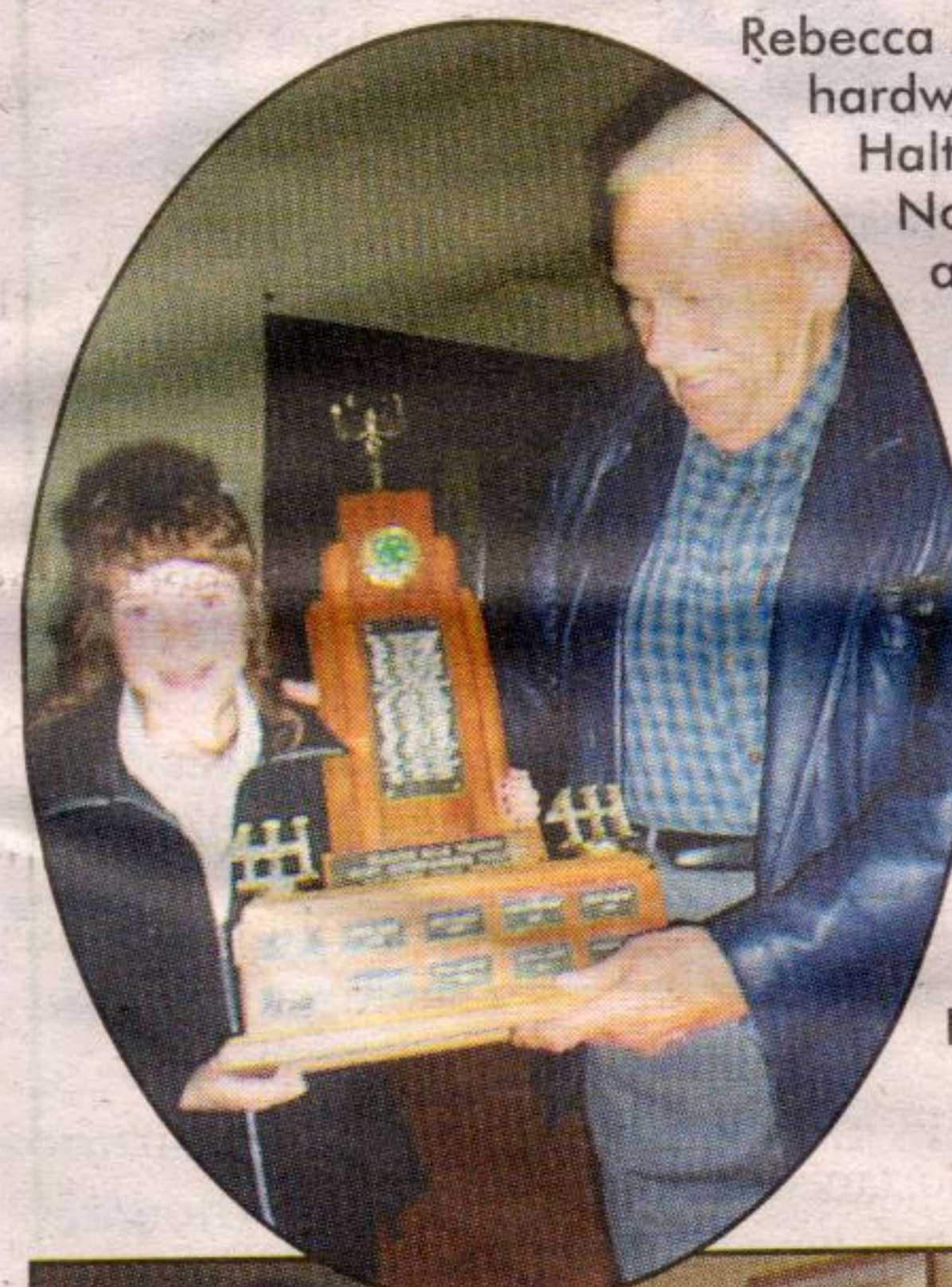


# 4-H Members honoured at Awards

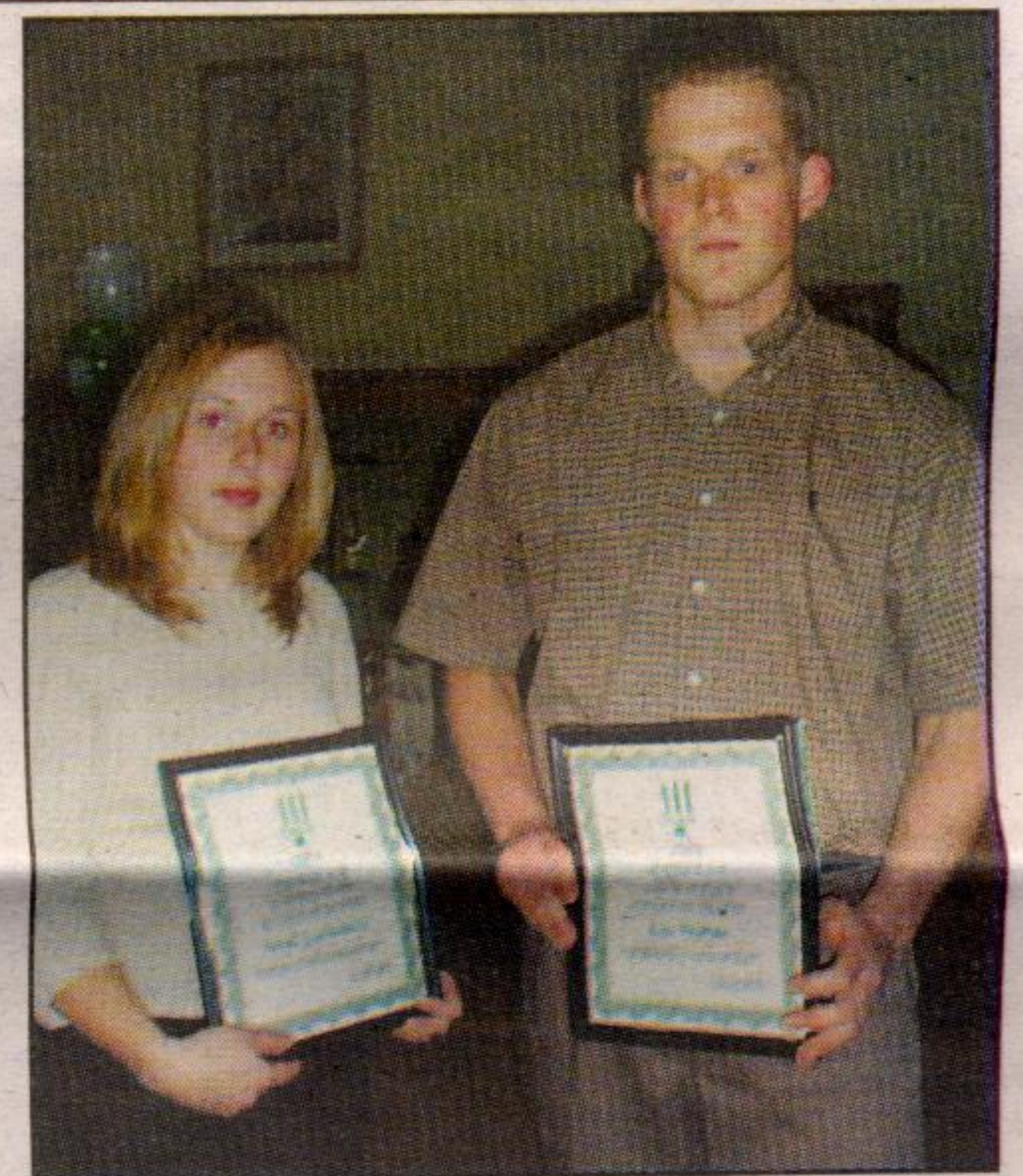
